PROFESSION OF FAITH (ELW p. 229)

I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church.

Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God, the powers of this world that rebel against God, and the ways of sin that draw you from God? Response: I renounce them. *Congregation please rise.* Do you believe in God the Father, Jesus Christ, the Son of God, and the Holy Spirit? 
