DAY 1 – CONSECRATION: SETTING OUR HEARTS

Scripture: James 4:8

Devotion: We don't start fasting by asking God for things—we start by giving Him our hearts. Consecration means setting ourselves apart for God's purposes. This is a moment to say, "Lord, I want You more than comfort, clarity more than control, Your will more than my own."

Pray For: A clean heart and renewed passion for God; forgiveness and repentance where needed; a fresh hunger for prayer and Scripture Sensitivity to the Holy Spirit; Faith for the year ahead; Grace Life Church to impact lives and a year filled with miracles.



DAY 2 – SPIRITUAL HUNGER

Scripture: Matthew 5:6

Devotion: What we feed grows. Fasting weakens the flesh so the spirit can rise. God promises satisfaction, not to those who are perfect, but to those who are hungry.

Pray For: A deeper desire for God's presence; freedom from distractions and spiritual apathy; discipline to stay committed to the fast and Love for God's Word.



DAY 3 – REPENTANCE & FREEDOM

Scripture: Psalm 51:10–12

Devotion: Repentance is not shame—it's freedom. God doesn't expose to embarrass; He exposes to heal. True repentance restores joy and renews our spirit.

Pray For: Personal repentance and humility; freedom from hidden sin or compromise; healing from guilt and shame and a restored joy of salvation.



DAY 4 – TRUSTING GOD COMPLETELY

Scripture: Proverbs 3:5-6

Devotion: Fasting reveals what we truly trust. When control is stripped away, faith is built. God honors surrendered trust.

Pray For: Faith over fear; trust in God's direction for the future; release of anxiety and worry and confidence in God's promises.



DAY 5 – GOD’S WILL & DIRECTION

Scripture: Romans 12:1-2

Devotion: God’s will is revealed to surrendered lives. When we lay ourselves on the altar, God transforms our thinking and clarifies our steps.

Pray For: Clear direction for personal decisions; God’s will for Grace Life Church; wisdom for leadership and discernment in relationships and opportunities.



DAY 6 – STRENGTH IN WEAKNESS

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 12:9

Devotion: Weakness is not failure—it's an invitation for God's power. God's strength shines brightest when we admit our need.

Pray For: Strength for weary hearts; grace in areas of struggle; emotional and mental resilience and God's power to replace our weakness.



DAY 7 – REST & PEACE

Scripture: Matthew 11:28–30

Devotion: God never intended us to live burned out. Fasting helps us slow down and rest in His presence.

Pray For: Peace for anxious hearts; rest for families and marriages; renewal for leaders and volunteers and God's peace to guard minds.



DAY 8 – FAITH FOR THE IMPOSSIBLE

Scripture: Mark 9:23

Devotion: Faith grows when we pray beyond what we can fix. God specializes in impossible situations.

Pray For: Miracles and breakthroughs; Healing (physical, emotional, spiritual); Restoration in broken relationships and Impossible situations to shift.



DAY 9 – BREAKING STRONGHOLDS

Scripture: Isaiah 58:6

Devotion: Biblical fasting breaks chains. Addiction, fear, generational cycles, nothing is stronger than the power of Jesus.

Pray For: Freedom from addictions; breaking generational strongholds; victory over fear and doubt and deliverance and spiritual freedom.



DAY 10 – A TEACHABLE HEART

Scripture: Psalm 25:4-5

Devotion: God teaches those who are humble. When we listen more than speak, God leads us clearly.

Pray For: Humility and wisdom; a heart that hears God's voice; teachability in every season and spiritual maturity



DAY 11 – HEALING & WHOLENESS

Scripture: Jeremiah 30:17

Devotion: God is still a healer. He heals bodies, hearts, minds, and memories.

Pray For: Physical healing; emotional and mental healing; healing from trauma and past wounds and wholeness in families.



DAY 12 – UNITY AT GRACE LIFE CHURCH

Scripture: Psalm 133:1

Devotion: Unity invites God's blessing. The enemy attacks unity because he fears a unified church.

Pray For: Unity among leadership; healthy relationships in the church; protection from division and love and grace toward one another.



DAY 13 – POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Scripture: Acts 1:8

Devotion: We don't need more talent, we need more power. The Holy Spirit empowers us to live boldly.

Pray For: Fresh filling of the Holy Spirit; boldness in faith; spiritual gifts to operate and sensitivity to God's leading.



DAY 14 – GOD OUR PROVIDER

Scripture: Philippians 4:19

Devotion: God provides in ways we don't expect but always on time.

Pray For: Financial provision; jobs and open doors; wisdom in stewardship and provision for Grace Life Church.



DAY 15 – RESTORED JOY

Scripture: Nehemiah 8:10

Devotion: Joy returns when we refocus on God. Joy is strength for the journey.

Pray For: Joy replacing heaviness; emotional renewal; gratitude and praise and freedom from discouragement.



DAY 16 – SALVATION & EVANGELISM

Scripture: Matthew 28:19–20

Devotion: We fast not just for ourselves but for the lost. Every soul matters to God.

Pray For: Salvation for family and friends; boldness to share faith; open hearts in our community and growth in Grace Life Church.



DAY 17 – PEACE OVER ANXIETY

Scripture: Philippians 4:6–7

Devotion: Prayer replaces panic. God's peace is supernatural and sustaining.

Pray For: Peace over anxiety; mental clarity; trust in God's care and restful sleep.



DAY 18 – ENDURANCE & PERSEVERANCE

Scripture: Galatians 6:9

Devotion: Don't quit before the breakthrough. God rewards faithfulness.

Pray For: Strength to finish strong; faithfulness in trials; renewed hope and endurance in waiting seasons.



DAY 19 – TRUSTING GOD’S TIMING

Scripture: Ecclesiastes 3:11

Devotion: Waiting doesn’t mean wasted. God’s timing is perfect.

Pray For: Patience and trust; peace in waiting; confidence in God’s plan and surrender of timelines.



DAY 20 – EXPECTING MIRACLES

Scripture: Ephesians 3:20

Devotion: God still does miracles. Expect Him to move beyond what you can imagine.

Pray For: Miracles in families; breakthroughs in health and finances; testimonies to rise and God's glory to be seen.



DAY 21 – A YEAR OF MIRACLES

Scripture: Psalm 126:3

Devotion: We finish believing God for a year marked by miracles, growth, and faith. What God began, He will complete.

Pray For: Thanksgiving for what God has done.



The Year of The Church
