

Homemade Soft Taco Shells:

Sandie Graham's recipe

Ingredients

3 Cups Flour
1 tsp Baking Powder
1 tsp Salt
1 Cup Warm Water
¼ Cup Vegetable Oil

Directions

- Sift flour, powder, & salt. Stir in water & oil. Turn dough onto lightly floured surface & knead for 2-3 minutes until smooth & no lumps.
- Return dough to bowl, cover with damp cloth, & let sit for 10-15 minutes.
- Remove dough from bowl & divide into 10 balls. Leave pieces on counter & cover again with damp cloth for 10 minutes.
- Roll out each piece of dough on floured surface to 8 inches round.
- Heat a dry pan over medium heat & cook for 30 seconds on each side, or until light brown spots appear and tortilla puffs slightly.
