

Irish Soda Bread:

Ingredients

2 ½ Cups All-purpose Flour
3 TBSP Granulated Sugar
2 tsp Baking Powder
1 tsp Baking Soda
½ tsp Salt
1/3 Cup (5 or 6 TBSP) Cold Butter or
Margarine
1 ¼ Cups Buttermilk
½ Cup Raisins or Currants (*Optional)

Directions

Heat oven to 325F. In large bowl, mix flour, sugar, baking powder, baking soda, & salt. Cut in butter until it resembles coarse crumbs. Stir in buttermilk just until moistened. (*Add raisins or currants now)

Turn dough onto lightly floured surface; knead gently 10 times. Shape into ball. Place on greased baking sheet. Pat flat into 6-7 inch circle. Cut ½-inch deep cross in top of dough with sharp knife.

Bake until golden brown and a toothpick inserted comes out clean (40-60 minutes). Serve warm.

**Buttermilk Substitute:

Mix 1 TBSP Lemon Juice or Vinegar with enough milk to make 1 Cup Total Liquid. Let stand for 10 minutes.
