

- Presentation of Learning (POL) Days October 16, 2024 January 15, 2025 April 2, 2025 June 4, 2025
   6:00 pm 9:00 pm -
  - At the end of each 9 weeks, AVPA participates in "Presentations of Learning," which include, exhibitions, performances, portfolio presentations, and more. POLs allow students to showcase their culminating projects and are 25% of their overall grade for each 9 weeks.
  - o There will be NO afternoon bus transportation on POL Days.
  - o Students will be fed dinner and snacks before their presentations.
  - o Parents will be notified of the location of P.O.L.s at least one month in advance.
- Student Led Conference Days October 17, 2024 January 16, 2025 April 3, 2025 10:00 am 7:00 pm
  - Academy of Visual and Performing Arts invites students and their families to attend formal student-led conferences. A classroom teacher facilitates the meeting, but the student is in charge. During the conference, students explain their progress toward academic excellence, artistic excellence, and wellbeing. Students share:
    - the quarter grades in each class (PowerSchool)
    - assessment results from the STAAR Interim Assessment in Reading and Mathematics
    - teacher comments, attendance, student involvement, leadership, and behavior (if any).
    - Compendium Presentations: projects that show mastery of grade-level standards
  - Student-led conferences are parent/teacher/student conference days that are held on the AVPA campus,
     via Zoom conference, or by phone, as arranged in advance. The sign-up link will be sent to parents at least one month in advance.

#### Academic Growth in Reading and Math



According to the most recent STAAR Interim Assessment (March 2024), students are seeing up to two grade-level improvements in reading and math. At the end of each 9 weeks, students demonstrate responsibility for academic growth by participating in student-led conferences.





Special Populations

AVPA accepts all students including at-risk, students with disabilities, academically vulnerable, and gifted and talented. There are no auditions or academic requirements.



#### Musical Milestones

Some students come to AVPA without exposure to the arts. Within just four (4) months of picking up instruments, our students performed Duke Ellington for the City of Forest Hill, TX.





#### Gifted and Talented

Through universal gifted screening, 32% of our students have been identified as gifted and talented, including many twice-exceptional individuals (3x state avg.).



#### Arts Enrichment in Partnership with Big Thought



Our partnership with Big Thought provides 14 teaching artists weekly, enhancing arts education for all 230 students. Our students take additional weekly classes, including percussion, guitar, music production, comedy and drama, lyricism, and voice lessons.



#### Cycling Program

All students participate in a 14-week cycling program during physical education - one of Texas' only middle school cycling programs.





#### Conservatory **Programs**

Who are the arts for? Everyone! At AVPA, all students participate in the arts. Students explore six (6) conservatories: dance, digital media arts, literary arts, music, theatre, and visual arts.

All seventh-grade students learn how to use Unity to create interactive products and experiences in 2D, realtime 3D development (3D), augmented reality (AR), and virtual reality (VR). Students code with C# scripting and programming (Digital Media Arts).

AVPA offers all academic and conservatory programs, instructional resources, and art supplies and materials at no cost to families, thus eliminating a barrier to access.
