Set the Stage

- ✓ **Time Period after the resurrection and before the Ascension.**
- ✓ **40 Days normally thought of as testing OR proving**
- ✓ **Some had said that after the “Passover” the pandemic would be over.**
- ✓ **I am not sure how to see through this to completion ... look at yet another “40 Day Experience”**

John 21:13-19 (ESV)

¹³ Jesus came and took the bread and gave it to them, and so with the fish. ¹⁴ This was now the third time that Jesus was revealed to the disciples after he was raised from the dead. Jesus and Peter ¹⁵ When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?” He said to him, “Yes, Lord; you know that I love you.” He said to him, “Feed my lambs.”



.....To Get to this Point

SEVEN DISCIPLES ARE PRESENT – Represent

Bread for Spiritual Health. The Body is the Eyes, Hands and Feet.

John saw it, says as much, “It is the Lord.”

Peter hears a WORD and jumps into action.

Crazy Good Faith & THE ACTION MAN




John 21:13-19 (ESV)

¹⁶ He said to him a second time, “Simon, son of John, do you love me?” He said to him, “Yes, Lord; you know that I love you.” He said to him, “Tend my sheep.” ¹⁷ He said to him the third time, “Simon, son of John, do you love me?” Peter was grieved because he said to him the third time, “Do you love me?” and he said to him, “Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you.” Jesus said to him, “Feed my sheep.”



John 21:13-19 (ESV)

And after saying this he said to him, “Follow me.”



John 21 :13-14


- Its ok to have Jesus investigate you, much better than someone else. Jesus intends to heal Peter
- Interesting choice of “Bread” don’t you think?
- Where is the Wine- He said He wont drink of it until The Kingdom had come in its fullness.
- Dates back to the Last Supper (Passover) and the 4th glass of wine, not yet consumed
- SETS the tone for what is to happen.

John 21:15

So when they had dined, Jesus said to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, love you me more than these? He said to him, Yes, Lord; you know that I love you. He said to him, Feed my lambs.

- ❑ Imagine the awkward silence after the meal – all of the Disciples had to hang their head on their behavior during and after crucifixion.
- ❑ This was a “restoration meeting” from the start.
- ❑ When Jesus calls your NAME what will you do.





Peter answers humbly at first, reveals depth of brokenness as he answers.

3 Questions, 3 Answers, 3 flocks, 3 Confrontations, most of all 3 healings for Peter (The Shepard):

- 1. Prayer – Upper Room**
- 2. Preaching – Day of Pentecost**
- 3. Evidence of Holy Life Style – His Shadow Heals People**



And 3 healings for the Flock:

- 1. Jews - lambs**
- 2. Gentiles - sheep**
- 3. Despised – sheep**

Real revelation is in the “Feed My”

- 1. Lambs / Bos ko – pasture, fodder, graze**
- 2. Sheep / rule in feeding / shepherding**
- 3. Sheep / Bos ko – feed / keep**

Observations of Importance

- The most effective way to get forgiveness of self is to involve yourself in God's Will.
- Honest, Peter will need every bit of this to face the death of the Cross that history tells us.
- What Does Our Future hold?




