Testimony... Eddie Tait



"My children would not be here if it wasn't for my mother's choice to value life over the hurt"

Eddie Tait is an associate leader at Bethel in Austin, Texas. Before moving to Austin, Pastor Eddie was part of the leadership team of the Firestarters ministry at Bethel Church in Redding, California. Today, he sits with us to share his testimony and to reveal the truth about his father.

Eddie was born to wonderful parents. His dad was in the military and they moved a lot. Eddie's life began to change when his parents divorced when he was nine. He and his mom moved to Colorado and his dad remarried and lived in Southern California.


A few years later, Pastor Eddie found out that the person he had called "dad" was not actually his biological father. He learned that his mom was raped and he was the product of that horrible act. As a young man, Eddie was hurt, confused and started to believe that he was just an accident.

"It literally shifted the aspect of my life for quite a while. I let that become my identity, that I wasn't a purposed being, I was just an accident because of that," Eddie said.

Years later, he started seeking God in different places until he experienced love and power one day when he encountered God Himself. That is when he decided to not let his circumstances dictate his life.

"I used to really believe that I was just a product of choices or circumstances that either could or could not happen. I never really understood that I actually have the authority to be me, I never realize that I was a purposed person.

More of the things I have determined in my life is that I will never let my circumstances determine how I'm gonna live my life. I choose to be fully who I am," Pastor Eddie told GOD TV.



Eddie used to justify the choice to have an abortion when a baby is conceived through rape. His point of view was filter through the horrible act his biological dad did to his mom. He was furious and angry at his biological dad because he has hurt his mom and had taken advantage of her.

But when he powerfully encountered by God through a vision, he saw how important his life is.

"My children would not be here if it wasn't for my mother's choice to value life over the hurt," he stated.

Eddie saw how important the purpose of every person is no matter your circumstances.

"[God] showed me that my life without Him had no meaning, no value. He didn't even give me the option to see something different because, in His mind, there's nothing different. I was always created for a purpose," he added.

Pastor Eddie also emphasized that our purpose is greater than our choice and pain.

"Are we allowing people to say that 'my pain is greater than that life.' It's not true. I think it's by God's mercy and His love that He actually allow something so beautiful to come out of such traumatic experience," he said.

Life matters because every life has a great purpose. Every human is created to be a child of God and to display His glory. Do not justify taking someone's life with your pain and your circumstance.

Q 1. Hi Jamie Lyn. Thank you so much for taking time out and participating. Please tell me how you personally became awakened to taking a stand for life?

It is a joy to serve 3-in-1 The Voice and I am thankful you are standing up for life alongside us! I have always stood for life but, I really became awakened when I realized

that there is a voice many are hearing about the topic of abortion and a grievance when I realized that voice was not the voice of our Heavenly Father. There is an agenda that is being pushed by the world and I am shocked that christians are not speaking up as much as we could be here. I am grateful for those who are

taking a stand and who have been speaking up for years, but for this to REALLY change in America, we must join together and speak up with such love and humility and unfortunately, I have been too silent. I have heard peoples stories on all sides and places on this topic and I cannot be silent anymore. I have too much love for the mothers carrying a child that don't know what to do and are only hearing "abort" and too much love for the life and destiny of the child they're carrying to not stand up and speak.

Q2. When do you believe that life begins for a human being and why?

I believe that life starts at conception in the womb. It's the start of a life and dream of God's that I pray will live the abundant life the God has for them and their parents.

Q3. How did the Life Matters Campaign start at GOD TV and how did you become involved?

I hope they pay attention and whatever stirs that they pray for that and ask God what they can do to help.

Q5. 1200 Campuses is a huge outreach/goal. How will this be achieved?

Students for Life of America is an incredible organization that is actively on 1200 campuses across the U.S. and they are the ones helping stream this movie, Unplanned, on campuses and create a healthy and safe place to process and dialogue about it. We love and trust this organization and that is why we have decided to partner with them. This goal cannot be achieved without our help as people who will donate money to show this. 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Why Life Matters to Me Life is a delicate balance in all it's forms!

Life is a delicate balance in all it's forms. From Genesis to Revelation there is one constant narrative – LIFE. Whether it be the universe, plants, animals or human; life is created by God, talked about by God, promoted by God and loved by God. Life is precious and life has purpose.

Maybe, it was not possible for them to give the baby a home at that time of their life. However, somewhere in their community or further afield, there was a family waiting. There was a family who maybe couldn't have children who was more than willing to adopt. However, little thought was given to the unborn child, it was all about the hassle it was going to give this young mother, if she decided to keep the baby.

Over time, my shock soon turned to horror when they told me of their experiences of the actual abortion procedure. Abortion is not legal in Northern Ireland, although as abortion is now becoming more and more accessible globally, even that is now changing.

In 'those days' women had to travel to the 'mainland' UK to have a termination. Sworn to secrecy, I listened intently to their stories when they returned. Their sense of relief that it 'was over.' However, many years later and I mean decades, I learned that it is never really over. For years they had suffered in silence, wondering about that one child that never made it into the world.

Because of their decision, pressure from family and partners, they were burdened with guilt, especially now that they were married and had families. Some of these women never even told their husbands what had happened.

Jesus once said, "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." (John 10:10)

This scripture alone, encompasses God's will for man. So why does man constantly 'fight' God? If you are like me, a believer, you know that Jesus is the only hope for humanity. I often think of my friends all those years ago. I pray for their well-being and for the souls of the unborn babies that they carried, if even for a short time.

LIFE matters. It is as simple as that. It is a precious gift from God. Genesis 1: 27-28,

"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply,.."

We all make mistakes, we all fall short, we are not perfect. However, when we make decisions in life that affect the very existence of another human being, we are in uncharted territory. We must pull back. We must not act in haste but seek counsel. God provided man with commandments to help to protect him not to condemn. One thing the Bible is very clear on is that taking innocent life is wrong. That should surely be our guideline.

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Abort or not to Abort? This is the Question



Testimony of Deborah Armin

Deborah grew up in South Africa and Kuwait, before returning to England as a teenager when her parents separated. While working in America she became suicidal, had an encounter with God and promised Him she would help others in the same situations she had faced. On My Way Home is her life story. I don't think unless you're completely heartless abortion is an easy decision.

I can remember the day I decided to have an abortion. I was 16, I'd been out clubbing, got drunk and had unprotected sex with a stranger. He said he would stop in time, he didn't. In the heat of the moment, we're all capable of doing stupid things. I wasn't yet a Christian and I don't remember anyone saying much about contraception. When I found out I was pregnant I was petrified and I didn't say anything to anyone. That was until my mother noticed my uniform being unusually tight at the front of my skirt.

Understandably she was furious and insisted I have an abortion. In her mind, she herself being a single mother, there was no other choice and I wasn't offered any other choices by the doctor I went to see either. My older sister was drafted in to help locate a suitable place for the abortion and I was duly transported and checked in. The doctors and nurses at the clinic didn't try to stop me. I was scared, ashamed and embarrassed but I didn't know what else to do. I still lived at home and the father of the baby was long gone.

I felt sick waiting to be admitted, my stomach in knots, palms sweating. The clinic was like a mini hospital and it had that familiar hospital smell, antiseptic mixed with goodness knows what. Finally, the time came to be led away by the nurse and prepped for surgery, I wanted to throw up. I remember shaking and asking myself, "Am I really just about to have an abortion?"

Waking up in the recovery room it felt like my insides had been ripped out, like the worst kind of period pain and I was so emotional. I could hear someone crying in an adjacent bed that had the curtains drawn around them. I was discharged later on that afternoon as if nothing much had happened. Funny they didn't warn me about the feelings of guilt and shame that trailed behind me.

I wish I could say that was an isolated incident, but it happened again, although the circumstances were different. This time instead of a drunken one night stand I fell for my ex-boyfriend's advances, and as he pinned me down at that moment he said, "I didn't want to lose you again so I thought if I got you pregnant you'd stay with me." He was wrong and I went through another ordeal having an abortion.

I went on to marry another man who after we were married decided he really didn't want children. I went along with him thinking he would change his mind and I wasn't quite ready anyway. But he didn't change his mind and it became part of the reason for our divorce.

I was 30 when we divorced and I believed I would find someone to start a family with, after all, I had time, right? I dated, I waited, I got engaged, I broke up and the whole cycle started again.

Then I became a Christian. Game changer.

Now my search for a husband had a whole different set of criteria and the playing field got really small! All the while the clock was ticking and I refused to have children out of wedlock. Even before I was a Christian I didn't believe in having children outside of marriage. But time kept marching on and before I knew it I went through the change.

How did that happen?

Now I know that miracles still happen, and there's adoption, fostering, etc. Or becoming a step-mum. There are options. But I will never go through the life-changing experience of being pregnant, marveling at the growing child inside. I won't feel them kicking or see their scan, or hear my babies first cry, or have that intimacy of breastfeeding. I won't get to be fussed on at a baby shower or everywhere I go people fussing over me, the expectant mum. I won't hear the word "mummy" or experience those tight hugs around the neck that children are so good at. I could go on.

And, ok I hear you saying, "No and you won't be sleep deprived either" and all the other trying things about motherhood. That's true. But I will never stop wondering who my children would have become, I could have added mother to my list of things of who I am. I will never be celebrated on Mothers' Day or the church celebrations that come around every year where mothers get flowers handed to them by other peoples children. It's painful. I can't stop others being celebrated nor would I, but I hesitate attending anywhere or anything if it means I'm reminded that I'm not the mother I wanted to be.


Today abortion has become so easily attainable, even celebrated. It has become contraception, a form of gender selection, and the cut off date for an abortion is being pushed later all the time. But if I can dissuade just one person from rushing their decision about whether to have an abortion then I would have done my job.


God knows the plans He has for you and your baby. Don't rush to end that plan. Seek advice, get support, check your options and think about the long-term consequences.

I'm reminded of a scripture, God said

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations."

Make sure the decision you make is one you can live with for life before you end a life.





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
