HAITI UPDATE – METRO REPORT

The local church we are partnered with in the Carrefour area of Port –au- Prince, Haiti was completely destroyed during the earthquake. As you know, from the news, hundreds of thousands of people are left without anywhere to go. Now, over 4,000 men, women and children have turned to our church parking lot to be their temporary “home.” We are doing whatever we can to help our Metro folks meet the needs of their fellow Haitians.

Currently, we’re working with a well-established relief organization to deliver much needed supplies; food, bull horns (for crowd control), personal tents, basic medical supplies, a refurbished truck and a 200 person tent so church services can continue.

These supplies only cover a small fraction of the need. As time goes on, the need will continue to grow. We’re not only trying to meet the physical needs. The people of Haiti are hungry for hope; a hope that lasts- the hope of Jesus Christ. That’s why we’re there and will continue to help re-build and carry on Sunday School.
