

Creamton Fly Fishing Club Standing Rules

Logistics:

1. Although the Creamton Flyfishing Club is a private Club, a Pennsylvania Fishing License with a Trout Stamp are required. All PA Fish Commission laws apply.
2. The club strongly encourages catch-and-release to preserve our fish population. If you wish to kill a fish, please use discretion, and consider size and species.
3. Members are required to sign in within 24 Hours via the eLog each time they access the club. If you bring a guest, they must also sign in via eLog and complete the waiver process.
 - 3a: First offense for not signing in receives a friendly warning.
 - 3b: Second offense receives a fine of \$20.00.
 - 3c: Third offense results in member's guest privileges being revoked for that season.
4. Consumption of alcohol should be confined to the Cabin and its immediate grounds.
5. If a member has a guest who brings a car to the Club, please use only one car while fishing. The second car may be parked at the cabin.
6. Although the board encourages members to limit time in certain desirable fishing areas, i.e., Baird's, Mead's, Fitz's, Picnic Pool, Bill's..., we recognize that this is a very subjective guideline. We do not see the need for a member to move on if no one else is at the club at that point in time. In certain areas where parking is not an issue, members are encouraged to join one another or others who might be there first, as there is normally room for more than one. In areas where parking is an issue, members are encouraged to stop if they want and quickly ask when the pool might free up as they would like to fish there later that day. Specifically, in the case of Mead's, it is only a short walk from the clubhouse to the bridge area and anyone can access it that way. Another alternative for that area is to ask one of the members there if they would mind driving over to the clubhouse and picking you up as parking is limited.
7. When parking at Mead's Bridge - only one car in the pull-off next to the USGS Gauge structure. A second car may park on the road. No more than 2 cars. No Exceptions please.
8. Please drive slowly. Especially on Johnson Creek Drive to the Cabin. WATCH THE DUST! NO U-TURNS to keep our landowners happy.
9. Our landowners and their neighbors along the water are essential to our success. Be a good neighbor and always wave or give a beep hello.
10. Please use the outhouse at the Cabin or be discreet in other areas. ABSOLUTELY NO RELEAVING YOURSELF AT MEAD'S BRIDGE AREA or in any area where you might be observed.
11. If you meet someone on the stream that is unfamiliar to you and they don't have a CFFC car tag, introduce yourself and get their name if you can. If they are not a member or the guest of the landowner contact the Board of Directors. DO NOT attempt to chase the person from the property.

12. The Club may not be used for outside (non-member) commercial guiding.

13. Ensure the cabin is clean when you leave and take all your garbage, including recyclables, with you.

14. In order to stem the spread of invasive species and organisms in our water, members are encouraged to either keep a pair of waders or wading shoes specifically for our river, or, to use appropriate cleaning measures, such as the Clorox wading shoe bath, at the cabin before and after fishing. Members are responsible for their guests to follow these procedures. Please ask board members for more information.

15. Members need to remain aware of the areas where the club DOES NOT currently have landowner permission to fish on their property.

Financial

1. The yearly membership fee shall be payable by March 1. A member may not fish until payment is received. If not paid by April 1, membership is suspended for that year until paid.

2. The Club land share fee must be paid in full before a candidate becomes a provisional member. A provisional member will have all the rights and privileges of membership except the right to cast a vote at club meetings.

3. Spouses, member's children, and member's grandchildren under 21 can fish an unlimited number of times with no fee while accompanied by a member. Parents, grandparents, children 21 and over, spouses of children, and guests are limited to three days of fishing at the daily rate of \$20 per season and must be accompanied by a member. Any other guest, including those on the CFFC waiting list, are limited to 3 visits per season at the daily rate of \$20.00 and must be accompanied by a member. No guest may access club waters without a member present.

3a. Member's children and grandchildren aged 12 and under may fish club waters using artificial lures with a single barbless hook on a catch and release basis and must be under direct supervision of a member.

4. Active-duty members of the Armed Forces are eligible for up to 4 years of dues exemption/deferral for years during which they cannot access the Club due to deployment.

5. Members who choose to resign their membership will be reimbursed \$200 from their portion of the land share fee regardless of when they submit their resignation.
