Sertoma Star Services is a not-for-profit community organization dedicated to challenging the limits and changing the lives of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

The organization was formed by merging two well-established organizations with a similar mission and service area. Sertoma Centre and New Star have a collective 120-plus years of supporting people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Together as Sertoma Star Services the committment to deliver comprehensive services,choices,and opportunities thatpromote self advocacy and perosnal success. As a result of the merger, they are now serving twice the number of individuals. Today, they serve over 2,000 individuals and their families throughout the Chicagoland area and Northwest Indiana. Their programs are driven by their passion for creating life changing vocational, educational,therapeutic and residential opportunities.

They serve individuals from age 5 to 95 and include those with Epilepsy,Cerebal Palsy, Autism and other substantial chronic disabilities incurred before maturity, in addtiion to those living with Anxiety, Depression, Trauma, Bipolar Disorders and other mental health concerns.

Sertoma Star Services vision is to build a future where all people with disabilities and those living with mental health illness, live, work and fully participate as productive and valued citizens of their community and society.

Speech & Hearing Center

Hearing does not happen in the ears. Your ears are funnels for sound waves to get to your brain. Hearing is a brain task. Hearing loss is not “an old person’s issue”, can be managed, and impacts your relationships, work productivity, and ability to remain engaged in activities you love. Changes in hearing can cause social isolation, academic and behavioral issues in children/teens, communication challenges, increased fall risk, job loss, and cognitive decline. Sertoma Speech and Hearing Center has provided hearing healthcare in the south and

southwest suburbs for 46 years. When people have access to proper hearing care, they stay engaged and connected, enhancing their quality of life and contributing more effectively to their communities. Improved hearing helps prevent isolation, supports mental health, and fosters inclusivity, creating a more cohesive and supportive environment for all. Hearing healthcare plays a vital role in cognitive health. Untreated hearing loss can lead to academic difficulties in children and cognitive decline in adults because the brain relies on auditory input for processing and memory. When hearing is compromised, the brain’s cognitive resources are diverted from other tasks, potentially accelerating dementia and cognitive disorders. By addressing hearing loss early with appropriate treatments, such as hearing aids or therapy, individuals can better engage in mental activities, maintain cognitive function, and reduce the risk of cognitive decline, thereby supporting overall brain health. Sertoma Speech and Hearing Center supports our communities by offering a range of services that enhance hearing and speech health. They provide comprehensive hearing evaluations, hearing aid fittings, and speech therapy for individuals of all ages. Our programs are often designed to be affordable or offer financial assistance, ensuring that those in need receive care regardless of their economic situation.

Did you know.....

The Sertoma Speech & Hearing Center is a not for profit organization dedicated to speech & hearing care for infants to senior adults.

Action Sertoma also contributes to Sertoma, Inc., Sertoma Speech & Hearing Centers and to other fine organizations such as Together We Cope, Crisis Center of South Suburbia as well as to many individuals in need within our community.

Action Sertoma Club consists of over 60 members. Our club is made up of women and men, working and retired. We are made up solely of volunteers and we grow and promote the need for volunteers in our community.
