He participated in Sertoma's sheltered workshop for many years, acquiring both work experience and skills. Ramone also worked at Sertoma's Snack Shack during lunch, distributing snacks to his fellow Consumers. He possesses an excellent work ethic and is a quick learner.

Today, Ramone lives with his sisters Tanya, Brenda, and niece Tiffany. He is very motivated and keeps himself busy completing his household chores and caring for his dog Coby. He loves shopping, attending weekly church services, and watching wrestling.

In addition to participating in Sertoma Centre programs, Ramone is among our most faithful volunteers at special events, along with his sister Tanya. He also volunteers for the Ronald McDonald House in

Chicago, and the Bears organization helping to cook and distribute meals to needy families.

His parents were encouraged to enroll Matthew in "all the therapies" when he was an infant and after aging out of Early Intervention, they chose Sertoma Speech and Hearing Center to join Matthew's care team. He received speech therapy at SSHC once weekly for several years to facilitate language skills, conversational intelligibility, and oral motor skills to supplement services provided in the schools as well as regular hearing evaluations to ensure he was hearing well. Matthew enjoyed therapy, was eager to talk to anyone who would listen, and became a favorite at the clinic.



Reading is a favorite activity for Matthew, especially about presidents. Ask him anything about U.S. Presidents and he'll have an accurate, well-thoughtout response. His favorite president is Abraham Lincoln. Matthew also enjoys classic cars, video games, hanging out with friends, and Ozzy Osbourne. All the things a young adult enjoys. He is a Special Olympian in basketball, floor hockey, golf, softball and recently a multi-medal winner in powerlifting in the 134# class at the Illinois State Games this year.

Matthew is a productive member of his community. He is working full-time at Jewel as a stocker/bagger. He is well liked by his managers and co-workers and can be counted on to be on time, productive, and provide good customer service. His management team reports Matthew is articulate, polite, and hard-working. His speech is clear, easy to understand, and customers of all ages enjoy conversing with him. Matthew continues

to use SSHC for his hearing healthcare with annual hearing testing and cerumen removal. He also serves as a volunteer at Sertoma Tuesday Bingo, in the SSHC clinic doing the heavy lifting (we love his Powerlifting prowess), and scanning/shredding work. Matthew is well liked by his Bingo volunteer team and the players. He has arranged his Jewel schedule to ensure he is at Bingo every Tuesday morning to chat with all the players and his fellow volunteers. Matthew makes friends everywhere he goes and his ability to speak clearly is never a concern.
