

Action Sertoma QUEEN OF HEARTS Raffle Details/Rules

1. Drawing is scheduled every Tuesday, 8 pm at Nite Games located at 5544 147th St, Oak Forest, IL 60452. The QUEEN OF HEARTS game board will be displayed at Nite Games.
2. Minimal Tickets to purchase are six for \$5.00. There is no limit to purchase \$5 set of tickets. All players must be 21 years of age or older. Tickets may be purchased at Nite Games every day and up to five minutes before drawing. QUEEN OF HEARTS Winner need not be present at time of drawing.
3. Other Ticket Sales options - Contact an Action Sertoma Member, or email actionsertoma@gmail.com or purchase online at www.actionsertoma.org, CLICK QUEEN OF HEARTS tab. Tickets and monies are due to the Action Sertoma Treasurer no later than Monday, 5 pm for Tuesday drawing. Thereafter, feel free to purchase tickets at Nite Games.
4. Each player must write his or her name, phone number and deck card number on the back of their raffle ticket. There may only be one player name placed on each ticket. If more than one name is on the ticket, the first name will be announced for the ticket drawn and will be responsible for QUEEN OF HEARTS winnings. Should their ticket be pulled for a consolation prize, the first name will be the winner and must be present.
5. Each game will begin with a full deck of cards including two jokers. A number, from 1 through 54, will be on the back of each card displayed on the board.
6. Every Tuesday at Nite Games, a ticket will be pulled from the ticket drum by a Nite Games Staff Member.
7. Drawings will not be held on Holidays, therefore, will be scheduled the following non-holiday Tuesday.
8. The jackpot will continue to accumulate weekly until the QUEEN OF HEARTS is drawn and ending the game. The jackpot amount will be based on ticket sales the week leading up to drawing. The jackpot will be announced at the time of drawing. After the ticket is drawn the updated jackpot will be predominantly displayed at Nite Games and on Action Sertoma Facebook Page until the next drawing.
9. If the QUEEN OF HEARTS is drawn and the player is present, he/she will win 60% of the jackpot. If the player is not present, he/she will win 50% of the jackpot. The remaining amount in the jackpot (after the award to the winner) will be awarded to Action Sertoma, the sponsor of the game.
10. If the QUEEN OF HEARTS is not drawn there are consolation prizes for Jokers, other three queens and A's. Winner must be present to receive consolation prize. If one of the jokers is drawn, the player will receive \$250. If one of the other three queens OR four A's is drawn, the winning player will receive \$100. All other cards have no payout value.
11. Once a card is selected, it will be removed from play for the remainder of each game and displayed face up on the board. Each week after the drawing, all tickets for that week's drawing will be destroyed.
12. The QUEEN OF HEARTS winning player must have a government issued photo ID to claim his or her prize. The winner is responsible for all taxes that relate to his or her winnings. A W-2 will be issued by Action Sertoma to the winning player. The award for drawing the QUEEN OF HEARTS will not be paid until all information required to complete the W-2 is provided by the winning player. If a player is unwilling or unable to provide the necessary W-2 information at that time, the successful player's award will remain as a part of the jackpot.
13. Should there be any disagreement regarding the procedure or the results of the game, then the disagreement or results will be resolved in a timely manner by way of/from the Action Sertoma Treasurer, who will be advised by a CPA from an accounting firm designated by Action Sertoma. The determination will be final by Treasurer and CPA.
14. All players, evidenced by the purchase of a ticket, agree to this form of binding arbitration.
15. This game is intended to conform to all City, State, and other requirements, including, but not limited to the City of Oak Forest and the State of Illinois, ordinance-governing games of chance. The game itself, and any of the Rules of the game, shall not violate any law, rule or regulation and the Rules shall be interpreted, to not violate such law, rule, or regulation.
