Natural gas safety and you

Smell gas?

Look for blowing dirt, discolored vegetation, or continued bubbling in standing water.

Listen for a hissing or roaring noise of natural gas escaping near an appliance or line.

Smell for the distinctive, rotten-egg odor associated with natural gas. Natural gas is colorless and odorless, so we add a chemical odorant call mercaptan for easy detection. This odorant has a distinctive "rotten egg" type odor. You should act any time you detect even a small amount of this odor in the air. Be aware that "odorant fade," while uncommon, can occur. Odorant fade occurs when a physical or chemical process causes the level of odorant in the gas to be reduced. This can happen in both existing gas pipe and new installations.


Call Nicor Gas at **888.642.6748** or **911** once you are out of the area of the suspected leak and in a safe place. Stay away until Nicor Gas or emergency personnel indicate it is safe to return.


