An excerpt from "Paul's Letter to American Christians," Sermon Delivered at Dexter Ave. Baptist Church, 4 Nov. 1956, Montgomery, AL, by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.



"But America, as I look at you from afar, I wonder whether your moral and spiritual progress has been commensurate with your scientific progress. It seems to me that your moral progress lags behind your scientific progress. Your poet Thoreau used to talk about "improved means to an unimproved end." How often this is true. You have allowed the material means by which you live to outdistance the spiritual ends for which you live. You have allowed your mentality to outrun your morality. You have allowed your civilization to outdistance

your culture. Through your scientific genius

you have made of the world a neighborhood, but through your moral and spiritual genius you have failed to make of it a brotherhood. So America, I would urge you to keep your moral advances abreast with your scientific advances."






