SOUTHERN ARIZONA TEEN AVIATION
AVIATION CAREER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

General Eligibility Requirements

Any SATA student with a minimum of one complete school year of SATA program attendance.

At least 17 years of age and an active SATA student at the time of application for a scholarship.

Application Process

Students must submit an application essay requesting consideration for financial assistance. The essay should reflect the student's knowledge of aviation career opportunities, goals, and specific plans to achieve the goals.

Scholarship Award Criteria

Application Essay evaluation.

Excellent attendance record.

Positive, cooperative, accommodating attitude, and program participation.

Parental encouragement and support (non-financial).

SATA Mentor sponsorship.

Flight Training Scholarship specifics and requirements

\$1250 for initial flight training exposure, or up to 5 hours flight training at a training facility approved by the SATA board of directors.

If initial training exposure is successful, SATA provides either a Sport Pilot online ground school and test preparation package or private pilot online ground school and test preparation package.

Successful completion of the FAA written exam qualifies student for additional flight training financial support up to a maximum of \$5000 including initial grant.

Flight training scholarships continue to be valid during school breaks and after graduation from High School as long as started prior to graduation and the successful completion of FAA written exam.

Financial payments will normally be managed directly between SATA and flight school, or by reimbursement upon presentation of paid flight school invoices as predetermined between SATA and student.

Non-flight Aviation Career program specifics and requirements

Successful graduation from High School.

SATA approved academic programs, such as Pima Aviation Maintenance, Aviation / Airport Management, Air Traffic Control, and similar programs.

\$1250 per semester tuition assistance.

\$250 initial books and supplies allowance.

Passing grades continue tuition assistance up to a \$5000 maximum including initial grant.

Financial payments will normally be by reimbursement upon presentation of paid tuition invoices or receipt by prior arrangement.

All scholarships are awarded at the sole discretion of the SATA board of directors, and reserve the right to discontinue any awarded scholarships.
