MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

ONLINE REGISTRATION & ACCOUNT MANAGEMENT

All enrollments are made via the iClassPro online registration system. Primary account holders are required to be parents/guardians or athletes who are at least 18 years old. Primary account holders are responsible for managing and maintaining their account information, including enrollments, billing, contact, and athlete information.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

All Parents/guardians and primary account holders assume full financial responsibility for any enrollments and all associated charges, including past-due balances, late fees, and other fees. All tuition and fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. If tuition or fees remain past due for more than (90) days, we will refer the matter to a third-party debt collector. Parents/guardians and primary account holders shall be responsible for any associated fees, including attorney fees.

STORED PAYMENT METHOD ON FILE

React Elite Cheer requires any/all primary account holders to maintain a valid stored payment method on file, such as a credit or debit card. A fee of \$10.00 per month will be assessed to accounts without a valid stored payment method on file.

BILLING & LATE FEES PRIMARY (A) INITIALS: PRIMARY (B) INITIALS:

Monthly tuition for recurring services, including classes and teams, is due in full on the first day of each month. Recurring billing is processed on the 1st and again on the 11th of each month if payment does not clear. Special events and additional competitions may follow a different billing schedule. Recurring billing will process the balance due, including current and past unpaid balances. Late fees will be assessed for accounts with past outstanding balances on the 4th of the month, as follows:

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Tuition, membership, registration, equipment, competition, apparel, music, and separation fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

ADJUSTMENTS DUE TO PANDEMIC OR OTHER CIRCUMSTANCES

In the event of a pandemic-related or similar situation, or if the season is delayed or significantly shortened, we may consider adjusting tuition rates and season-end dates as needed. Any changes will be communicated via email to account holders.

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEE

A \$45.00 Annual Membership Fee will apply upon enrollment and will renew annually. The annual Membership Fee allows the athlete to access React Elite classes and private lessons and participate on a Tiny, Mini, Youth, Junior, Senior, or Open team in our Elite, Prep, or Novice Programs. The Membership Fee does not apply to athletes attending Open Gym, special events/camps/workshops, or one-time private lessons from out-of-state only.

CLASS POLICIES

Class tuition is not based on attendance but instead reserves that athlete's spot. The athlete will remain enrolled in the class until a "drop request" is submitted and approved. Class tuition is only prorated upon the initial class enrollment. Tuition will not be prorated for missed classes, gym closures due to holidays, or inclement weather. Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable. In the event of an absence, a make-up token will be generated. Make-up tokens may be applied to a class if the athlete is actively enrolled. An athlete may receive up to (3) make-up tokens per calendar year. These tokens do not carry over, nor do they carry any cash value.

If a class no longer meets your current needs, please contact our coaching staff for class recommendations and private lessons. In addition, athletes that progress beyond the level they are placed at their tryout/evaluation will be moved up accordingly.

ATHLETE GUIDELINES

Athletes are required to maintain/improve skills that are considered elite in the level they are competing. Our coaching staff reserves the right to remove any athlete from their team based on (but not limited to) performance and decreased skills. All athletes must maintain perfect attendance during competition season.

Athletes must maintain and improve skills shown at their tryouts/evaluations. Coaches will evaluate athlete skills (Tumbling/Stunting/Jumps/Dance) every month to maintain team & athlete progression. Any athlete not maintaining the required skills for their level will be moved to a team that best fits their current needs. Please contact our coaching staff for class recommendations and private lessons. In addition, athletes that progress beyond the level they are placed at their tryout/evaluation will be moved up accordingly

TEAM GUIDELINES FOR TRAVELING

React Elite Cheer team members will travel with their families, friends, adults/chaperone, and parents/legal guardian. All team members will be responsible for booking their travel and accommodations for every trip.

STAY-TO-PLAY

PRIMARY (A) INITIALS:

Some of the competitions we attend are "Housing Required" events. This policy is also referred to as "Stay-to-Play." This means the competition event producer(s) require families to book accommodations through Team Travel Source with booking links provided later. This is a requirement of Varsity and the event producers, not React Elite Cheer.

This policy helps ensure specific venues, dates, and discounted rates, along with other benefits. Therefore, all families will be expected to adhere to this booking policy if required.

CLASS PROGRAM WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE PRIMARY (A) INITIALS: PRIMARY (B) INITIALS:

To successfully withdraw from a class, the primary account holder must submit a "drop request" in the iClassPro Customer Portal. Email, phone call, text message, fax, handwritten note, or verbal notification are NOT acceptable forms of notification to withdraw. Drop requests must be received by the 20th of each month. Requests received after the 20th of the month will be processed with the following month's recommendations. Drop requests can be pre-selected by the date when enrolling.

TEAM MEMBER FINANCIAL COMMITMENT & POLICIES

We include All-Star team tuition in the monthly training tuition, which covers team practices, athletes' competition fees, and more. We calculate team tuition based on 11 months, not on attendance or the number of practices per month. We will draft the first month's tuition before the first practice and process all other payments on the 1st of each month. By enrolling in a tryout and verbally accepting a spot on the team when the coach calls with team details (team name, coach names, practice times), the guardian/athlete agrees to the financial commitment for the 11-month season. Tuition and fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. We apply payments received to team tuition balances first. Athletes with past due balances and no communication may not participate in private lessons, classes, or team practices.

React Elite Cheer can remove athletes from the program if they do not uphold their financial obligation. Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable. Accounts must be up to date to apply payments to additional events. Once we cover the tuition balance, we will apply payments to team travel fees.

We will provide details regarding additional fees for Worlds, Summit, Regional Summit, or similar end-of-season competitions via email from React Elite Cheer Management after the start of the season. We will share a fee schedule as soon as we confirm costs from the respective Event Producer. Please note that these events implement non-refundable/non-transferable policies or policies with penalties for React Elite Cheer; therefore, these fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

You must understand that we require a notice to terminate billing, and non-participation or non-attendance does not qualify as an acceptable form of resignation or "drop request." As our Terms and Conditions outline, all primary account holders will remain financially responsible for payment until we successfully withdraw the athlete from React Elite Cheer.

PROGRAM VIOLENCE POLICY

React Elite Cheer provides a safe place for all athletes and employees. To ensure a safe athletic space and to reduce the risk of violence, all React Elite Cheer athletes and their families and/or guests should review and understand all provisions of this program violence policy.

CONDUCT EXPECTATIONS AND DISCIPLINE PROCESS PRIMARY (B) INITIALS: Appropriate conduct from all athletes, family members, and their guests is expected at all times. Should any React Elite Cheer member(s) or their family and/or guests choose behavior that is inconsistent with the React Elite Cheer standards, management reserves the right to remove anyone from our program and premises. This includes but is not limited to verbal, electronic, and physical threats or altercations, derogatory comments about other React Elite Cheer athletes or staff. This policy extends to all USASF members and at all company and company-attended events. PROHIBITED CONDUCT PRIMARY (B) INITIALS: PRIMARY (A) INITIALS:_ React Elite Cheer does not tolerate any type of workplace violence committed by or against employees. Employees are prohibited from making threats or engaging in violent activities. This list of behaviors provides examples of conduct that is prohibited: Causing physical injury to another person. We try to be understanding and sensitive to what they are dealing with while still impressing upon our athletes how important it is to be present at every practice. Attendance is crucial to the success of our teams, athlete progression, and our program as a whole. Missing practice for homework, birthday dinners, parties, not having a ride, and all other nonillness/injury related reasons will not be considered as excused reasons to miss practice. We ask that if your child is ill and/or injured, he/she should still attend practice unless one or more of the following occurs. Vomiting and/or Diarrhea. Fever requiring a hospital/emergency room visit. Highly contagious airborne illness and/or an illness that is spread by general contact. Serious injury requiring physician/doctor recommended bed rest. In the event your athlete is going to miss practice for a graded school project or a choir/band concert; we require all families to submit an Absence Request Form for approval by our coaches. Please note, submitting a request form does not guarantee your request will be approved. Your request will be automatically denied if: Your request is submitted with less than three weeks between the date of your request being submitted and the date of the missed practice(s). The first time your athlete misses a mandatory practice leading up to a competition it will result in an Unexcused Absence Fee and your athlete not being allowed to compete in the upcoming event. If your athlete misses a second mandatory practice, a Separation Fee will be applied & charged to your account, and your athlete will be removed from the program. **Blackout Weeks** are mandatory, every athlete is expected to attend all practices leading up to competitions (2 weeks). **VACATIONS:** Please plan your vacations around our gym closures.
