TERMS & CONDITIONS

MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

ONLINE REGISTRATION & ACCOUNT MANAGEMENT

All enrollments are made via the iClassPro online registration system. Primary account holders are required to be parents/guardians or athletes who are at least 18 years old. Primary account holders are responsible for managing and maintaining their account information, including enrollments, billing, contact, and athlete information.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

All Parents/guardians and primary account holders assume full financial responsibility for any enrollments and all associated charges, including past-due balances, late fees, and other fees. All tuition and fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. If tuition or fees remain past due for more than (90) days, we will refer the matter to a third-party debt collector. Parents/guardians and primary account holders shall be responsible for any associated fees, including attorney fees.

STORED PAYMENT METHOD ON FILE

React Elite Cheer requires any/all primary account holders to maintain a valid stored payment method on file, such as a credit or debit card. A fee of **\$10.00** per month will be assessed to accounts without a valid stored payment method on file.

BILLING & LATE FEES

Monthly tuition for recurring services, including classes and teams, is due in full on the first day of each month. Recurring billing is processed on the 1st and again on the 11th of each month if payment does not clear. Special events and additional competitions may follow a different billing schedule. Recurring billing will process the balance due, including current and past unpaid balances. Late fees will be assessed for accounts with past outstanding balances on the 4th of the month, as follows:

- 1st Late Fee - \$25.00
- 2nd Late Fee - \$50.00
- 3rd Late Fee - \$75.00

NON-REFUNDABLE & NON-TRANSFERABLE FEES

Tuition, membership, registration, equipment, competition, apparel, music, and separation fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

ADJUSTMENTS DUE TO PANDEMIC OR OTHER CIRCUMSTANCES

In the event of a pandemic-related or similar situation, or if the season is delayed or significantly shortened, we may consider adjusting tuition rates and season-end dates as needed. Any changes will be communicated via email to account holders.

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEE

A \$45.00 Annual Membership Fee will apply upon enrollment and will renew annually. The annual Membership Fee allows the athlete to access React Elite classes and private lessons and participate on a Tiny, Mini, Youth, Junior, Senior, or Open team in our Elite, Prep, or Novice Programs. The Membership Fee does not apply to athletes attending Open Gym, special events/camps/workshops, or one-time private lessons from out-of-state only.

CLASS POLICIES

Class tuition is not based on attendance but instead reserves that athlete's spot. The athlete will remain enrolled in the class until a "drop request" is submitted and approved. Class tuition is only prorated upon the initial class enrollment. Tuition will not be prorated for missed classes, gym closures due to holidays, or inclement weather. Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable. In the event of an absence, a make-up token will be generated. Make-up tokens may be applied to a class if the athlete is actively enrolled. An athlete may receive up to (3) make-up tokens per calendar year. These tokens do not carry over, nor do they carry any cash value.

If a class no longer meets your current needs, please contact our coaching staff for class recommendations and private lessons. In addition, athletes that progress beyond the level they are placed at their tryout/evaluation will be moved up accordingly.

ATHLETE GUIDELINES

Athletes are required to maintain/improve skills that are considered elite in the level they are competing. Our coaching staff reserves the right to remove any athlete from their team based on (but not limited to) performance and decreased skills. All athletes must maintain perfect attendance during competition season.

Athletes must maintain and improve skills shown at their tryouts/evaluations. Coaches will evaluate athlete skills (Tumbling/Stunting/Jumps/Dance) every month to maintain team & athlete progression. Any athlete not maintaining the required skills for their level will be moved to a team that best fits their current needs. Please contact our coaching staff for class recommendations and private lessons. In addition, athletes that progress beyond the level they are placed at their tryout/evaluation will be moved up accordingly

TEAM GUIDELINES FOR TRAVELING

React Elite Cheer team members will travel with their families, friends, adults/chaperone, and parents/legal guardian. All team members will be responsible for booking their travel and accommodations for every trip.

STAY-TO-PLAY

Some of the competitions we attend are "Housing Required" events. This policy is also referred to as "Stay-to-Play." This means the competition event producer(s) require families to book accommodations through Team Travel Source with booking links provided later. This is a requirement of Varsity and the event producers, not React Elite Cheer.

This policy helps ensure specific venues, dates, and discounted rates, along with other benefits. Therefore, all families will be expected to adhere to this booking policy if required.

CLASS PROGRAM WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

To successfully withdraw from a class, the primary account holder must submit a "drop request" in the iClassPro Customer Portal. **Email, phone call, text message, fax, handwritten note, or verbal notification are NOT acceptable forms of notification to withdraw.** Drop requests must be received by the 20th of each month. Requests received after the 20th of the month will be processed with the following month's recommendations. Drop requests can be pre-selected by the date when enrolling.

TEAM MEMBER FINANCIAL COMMITMENT & POLICIES

We include All-Star team tuition in the monthly training tuition, which covers team practices, athletes' competition fees, choreography/music fees, levels camp, and more. We calculate team tuition based on 12 months, not on attendance or the number of practices per month. We will draft the first month's tuition before the first practice and process all other payments on the 1st of each month. By enrolling in a tryout and verbally accepting a spot on the team when the coach calls with team details (team name, coach names, practice times), the guardian/athlete agrees to the financial commitment for the 12-month season. Tuition and fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. We apply payments received to team tuition balances first. Athletes with past due balances and no communication may not participate in private lessons, classes, or team practices.

React Elite Cheer can remove athletes from the program if they do not uphold their financial obligation. Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable. Accounts must be up to date to apply payments to additional events. Once we cover the tuition balance, we will apply payments to team travel fees.

We will provide details regarding additional fees for Worlds, Summit, Regional Summit, or similar end-of-season competitions via email from React Elite Cheer Management after the start of the season. We will share a fee schedule as soon as we confirm costs from the respective Event Producer. Please note that these events implement non-refundable/non-transferable policies or policies with penalties for React Elite Cheer; therefore, these fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

You must understand that we require a notice to terminate billing, and non-participation or non-attendance does not qualify as an acceptable form of resignation or "drop request." As our Terms and Conditions outline, all primary account holders will remain financially responsible for payment until we successfully withdraw the athlete from React Elite Cheer.

SEPARATION AGREEMENT

While the growth and success of our athletes, teams, and program overall is our primary focus, we understand that not every program can meet the needs of every athlete and family. In the event that you find our program does not meet your needs, we allow separation at no charge until July 1st, 2024. Any breach of our athlete separation agreement, (voluntary or involuntary) that occurs after July 2nd, 2024, will incur a \$800.00 USD (Eight-Hundred Dollars) fee to compensate for the difficulty and disruption of re-training, adjusting stunt & pyramid groups, and re-choreographing routines. This fee will be billed immediately to your stored payment method on file upon receipt of the emailed Separation/Un-enrollment/Drop Request/Withdraw from our program. Penalty's will **ONLY** be waived for season ending injuries. In order for the penalty fee to be waived we require a doctor's note stating your injury and his/her recommendation for removal for the remainder of the season. The Primary account holder must provide us with a note via emailed (Info@reactcheer.com) on or before the date of unenrollment and the note must be dated on or before the date of unenrollment to waive the penalty fee. In order for your athlete(s) to be released from our program & USASF roster your account(s) must be in good standing at a \$0.00 (zero dollars) balance before we will release your athlete(s).

Tuition, Membership, Registration, Equipment, Competition, Apparel, Music, and Separation Fees, etc. are non-refundable and non-transferable.

APPAREL

In the case of Separation, ALL apparel will be forfeited without refund or credit.

PENALTY POLICIES

All-Star families are required to have a card on file authorizing us (React Elite Cheer) to process the \$800.00 USD (Eight-Hundred Dollars) Separation Fee in the event you, your athlete, and/or family (voluntarily or involuntarily) breach this agreement.

INVOLUNTARY SEPARATION

React Elite Cheer reserves the right to remove any athlete(s) from our program at the discretion of our coaches/instructors' and our management's discretion. Cause for removal from our program are (but not limited to) the following: Parent(s) and/or legal guardians' overall behavior and how they conduct themselves through social media, at competitions, in the gym, and throughout the season as a whole. Athlete(s) behavior, coachability, and interaction with their teammates, other athletes, coaches, and our staff will be taken into consideration. React Elite Cheer does not tolerate bullying, threats, or inappropriate behavior. We take the well-being and safety of the athletes and members of our program very seriously. Not having a mutual respect for one another will not be tolerated. Should an issue arise, we will not hesitate to excuse an athlete from our program.

PARENT & TEAM GUIDELINES:

Band App and email are two of the primary methods of communication we utilize, sending out updates and other pertinent information on a weekly basis if necessary. Parents are always welcome and encouraged to attend events both locally and nationally. If, for some reason, you disagree or are unhappy with a decision, judging at a competition, etc. We have a 24hr "cooling off" period prior to addressing/contacting a coach and/or staff member. Talking negatively amongst each other as parents or to your child can only hurt the program and will not be tolerated. Doing so can be cause for removal of your athlete(s) from the program. Consistent "drama" or "pot stirring" may be grounds for your child's removal from our program. All parents must agree to discuss any, and all problems or concerns related to the program, staff, cheerleaders, or other parents directly with the staff. Should an issue arise, publicly airing grievances or posting them on social media will not be tolerated. All parents must agree to accept all staff/management decisions as final and in the best interest of all parties. Parents, may not call meetings, hand out letters or flyers, send gym e-mails, create team Facebook pages, schedule fundraisers, or purchase wearable items for the teams without direct written permission of React Elite Cheer. We understand our parents enjoy traveling to competitions outside of our state and we want you to have a good time. However, React Elite Cheer will not tolerate illicit behavior, public intoxication, and any conduct that would be considered unbecoming of our program. Please remember we are there to compete at a competition and that you are not just representing yourself/family. You are a direct representation of React Elite Cheer and/or the program as a whole. Should an issue arise that causes React Elite Cheer to be looked at as unfavorably we reserve the right to request you leave the venue/competition and if necessary that your athlete be removed from the program.

PROGRAM VIOLENCE POLICY

React Elite Cheer provides a safe place for all athletes and employees. To ensure a safe athletic space and to reduce the risk of violence, all React Elite Cheer athletes and their families and/or guests should review and understand all provisions of this program violence policy.

CONDUCT EXPECTATIONS AND DISCIPLINE PROCESS

Appropriate conduct from all athletes, family members, and their guests is expected at all times. Should any React Elite Cheer member(s) or their family and/or guests choose behavior that is inconsistent with the React Elite Cheer standards, management reserves the right to remove anyone from our program and premises. This includes but is not limited to verbal, electronic, and physical threats or altercations, derogatory comments about other React Elite Cheer athletes or staff. This policy extends to all USASF members and at all company and company-attended events.

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

React Elite Cheer does not tolerate any type of workplace violence committed by or against employees. Employees are prohibited from making threats or engaging in violent activities. This list of behaviors provides examples of conduct that is prohibited:

- *Causing physical injury to another person.*
- *Making threatening remarks.*
- *Displaying aggressive or hostile behavior that creates a reasonable fear of injury to another person or subjects another individual to emotional distress.*
- *Intentionally damaging property or property of another React Elite member.*
- *Committing acts motivated by, or related to, sexual harassment or domestic violence.*

REPORTING PROCEDURES

Any potentially dangerous situations must be immediately reported to a React Elite Cheer staff member. All reported incidents will be investigated. Reports or incidents warranting confidentiality will be handled appropriately, and information will be disclosed to others only on a need-to-know basis. All parties involved in a situation will be counseled, and the results of investigations will be discussed with them.

ILLNESS, INJURY, AND ABSENCE

We understand that our families/athletes will occasionally deal with an illness and/or an emergency that requires him/her to miss practice. We try to be understanding and sensitive to what they are dealing with while still impressing upon our athletes how important it is to be present at every practice. Attendance is crucial to the success of our teams, athlete progression, and our program as a whole. Missing practice for homework, birthday dinners, parties, not having a ride, and all other non-illness/injury related reasons will not be considered as excused reasons to miss practice. We ask that if your child is ill and/or injured, he/she should still attend practice unless one or more of the following occurs.

- ❖ Vomiting and/or Diarrhea.
- ❖ Fever requiring a hospital/emergency room visit.
- ❖ Highly contagious airborne illness and/or an illness that is spread by general contact.
- ❖ Serious injury requiring physician/doctor recommended bed rest.

In the event your athlete is going to miss practice for a graded school project or a choir/band concert; we require all families to submit an Absence Request Form for approval by our coaches. Please note, submitting a request form does not guarantee your request will be approved. Your request will be automatically denied if: Your request is submitted with less than three weeks between the date of your request being submitted and the date of the missed practice(s).

The first time your athlete misses a mandatory practice leading up to a competition it will result in your athlete not being allowed to compete in the upcoming event. If your athlete misses a second mandatory practice, your athlete will be removed from the program.

Weeks are mandatory, every athlete is expected to attend all practices leading up to competitions.

VACATIONS: Please plan your vacations around our gym closures.

INJURY, ILLNESS, AND ABSENCE PROCEDURES

In the event that you have an emergency or that your child is so ill that he/she is unable to attend practice, we request that you contact React Elite via phone and/or e-mail prior to 3:00pm.

In the event your child has an illness and/or injury that requires him/her to miss more than (1) consecutive practices, we require a doctor's note to excuse them from practice as well as a doctor's note releasing them for full and/or partial participation at practice.

INJURY, ILLNESS, AND ABSENCE POLICIES

We require that you regularly communicate with the React Elite coaches, staff, and management regarding your child's illness/injury status. We require that you have a direct plan for treatment that will allow them to get back participating in practicing with their team as soon as possible.

Missing practices doesn't just affect the athlete and the progression of the athlete. It also affects the other athletes on his/her team. Athletes who have excessive absences may be removed from the program at the discretion of the React Elite Cheer coaching staff. Blackout

SURVEILLANCE NOTIFICATION

React Elite Cheer makes limited use of surveillance equipment to include camera and audio recordings. Media is collected from cameras that overlook training areas, staff common areas, athlete cubbies and parent viewing areas. Cameras are NOT located in areas where privacy is expected, E.G., the restroom. Should any type of audio or video equipment be discovered in private areas; notify office staff immediately and the authorities will be notified promptly. Our systems are used for liability purposes, insurance claim validation, injury review, and incidents where authorities are called, or violence has occurred. Footage will not be released to any patron or staff member directly. Local authorities, i.e., law enforcement or investigating authorities, with the appropriate Federal, State, or Local request to obtain footage or applicable by law; may obtain footage. By signing and entering the facility, including guests and other family members that may enter also, you acknowledge and consent to surveillance in accordance with our stated purpose and use. TEAM ROSTERS

No athlete is guaranteed a spot on our competition teams. Coaches reserve the right to change rosters, choreography, skills in routines, stunt groups, divisions, and/or the competition schedule at any point.

USASF MEMBERSHIP FEE

Mandatory of team athletes to participate.

If you have never cheered before as an All-Star athlete at any level, you must complete membership with the USASF upon accepting placement on a React Elite Cheer team. Athletes **MUST** upload a birth certificate or passport and a current performance ready headshot photo (neck up) to the USASF website.

If you were an All Star athlete at any level or from another program, you must renew. Adult athletes (those who are 18 years old or will turn 18 before June 1, 2025) must have a current background screening/check with a green light determination and Safe-Sport training. Exceptional athletes are excluded from this requirement. As of 3/17/22, US residents' fee is \$30 per athlete, Canadian residents fee is \$75 per athlete, and all other countries' fee is \$150 per athlete. This fee is payable to the NCSI at the time of processing. Valid driver's license or passport will be required. You may visit usaf.net to enroll or renew memberships and for additional details regarding membership benefits. Or you will be prompted with detailed information on "how to enroll/renew" by React Elite Cheer Management.

SAFESPORT/SAFE AT ALL-STAR

We align our safety training with USASF's SafeSport requirements, as well as our own enhanced React Elite Cheer protection of minors' policies. All coaches, team reps, vendors, Parent Coordinators, and support staff have had to complete the extensive SafeSport training annually, and we at React Elite Cheer will be training on this continually throughout this coming season. As an organization, we will continue this education with staff & coaches on a regularly scheduled basis and continue to guide our older athletes to understand the rules restricting athlete/athlete communication and relationships. More information on how athletes and their parents/guardians should complete these training/certifications will be provided upon the start of the season.

ARRIVAL AND PICK-UP

Be sure athletes arrive 5 to 10 minutes before (no earlier, please) their scheduled class/practice time. Please pick up your athlete on time! You may inform the Business Office if you know you will be late picking up. Instruct your athlete to wait inside the building and you should escort them from the building to the car. During peak times the parking lot is crowded! Please take extra caution for pedestrians and cars backing out, etc. Drive slowly, carefully, and always park legally. Cars that are parked illegally may be towed at the owner's expense.

Prep Program (L1.1 – L3.2): All teams that qualify will attend the 2025 West Regional Summit in Phoenix, AZ at the Phoenix Convention Center (April 2025). Families will be provided a payment plan and additional information within (10) days of their team qualifying for the event.

THE 2025 D2 SUMMIT (Orlando, FL)

Elite Program (Youth, Junior, and Senior): Teams must earn a bid (Wild Card, At-Large, Partial-Paid, or Paid) to attend the 2024 Summit at Disney Worlds ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex in Orlando, FL. All teams that earn a bid will attend the event. Families will be provided a payment plan and additional information within (10) days of their bid being awarded.

Beginning of the Season Showcase: All families are required to sell a minimum of (5) tickets per athlete. Tickets are \$10.00/ea. If you have multiple athletes, you are responsible for 5 tickets/athlete (for example: two athletes = 10 tickets).

Travel Cost: All costs associated with attending/traveling to the competitions such as, flights, hotels, rental car, food, etc.

Extra Practice: If necessary to prepare our team(s), our coaching staff will add required/mandatory additional practice times (*contingent on team & athlete progression*). A fee of \$10.00/athlete per practice will be charged to your account. We will do our best to provide as much notice as possible. However, there is no way to predict if and when a team will require additional practice time. Our competition preparation goes into high gear starting in October 2023 through April 2024. During such time, extra practices are usually scheduled.
