THE HOUSE

Our vision for Daniels House is to provide Veterans who need a permanent living situation upon successfully rehabilitating out of transitional housing and who are looking for a permanent home. Our goal is to provide a home for these Veterans, or anyone who is committed to a permanent housing solution and who want to live in a diverse and dynamic co-living environment.

Daniels House will support 5 residents. We welcome and encourage Veterans of all races, ages, genders, cultures, abilities (although we have stairs), to apply. We are looking for people who are excited to grow and commit to a permanent housing situation.

We are located near the Vallejo Waterfront and there is easy access to the Vallejo Ferry. Busses run along the main street and major highways 37 and Interstate 80 are close by.

We offer shared Kitchen and a common dining room. You'll also have access to the house's 3 bathrooms and a bricked private backyard patio.

THE PLAN

Renovations. Our plan for Daniels House is to complete cosmetic renovations as well as update the bathrooms and use existing space to create a downstairs bedroom for any mobility challenged tenant. We know our homeless veteran community is ageing and we want everyone to have the ability to live in our community home. We will also update the bathrooms and the kitchen, as well as clean up the backyard for our tenants.

The Program. We will master lease to an off-site, non-profit Veterans Housing organization to care for the residents and provide program opportunities for them and assist them with any needs. David Sowels and his team will oversee the entire program.
