- 1. Do not "dry fire" the bow. This means do not pull the bow string back and let go without an arrow. This will cause damage to the bow and may injure the archer.
- 2. Straddle the shooting line (one foot on each side) when shooting.
- 3. Always point arrows down range towards the target.
- 4. Never shoot the arrow straight up.
- 5. Only shoot one arrow at a time.
- 6. Once you have shot all your arrows, step back from the shooting line and place your bow on the rack and wait for all shooters in the lane to finish.
- 7. Do not retrieve arrows until all arrows on the range have been shot and no arrows remain in the quivers.
- 8. Only one person at a time may pull arrows from the target. Make sure no one is directly behind you when pulling arrows from target.
- 9. Always use two hands to remove arrows from target. Keep hands close to target when pulling to prevent bending the arrow.
- 10. Always use two hands to carry arrows back to the shooting line with one hand covering the tips of the arrows. Place arrows tip down in quiver.
