WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Johnston have determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to amend the Town ordinances concerning public nuisances and to add regulations concerning penalties as stated in the Johnston Code of Ordinance, Section 10.99;		
Whereas, the Council of the Town of Johnston has concluded that the amendment of this ordinance is essential to give the courts options to set penalties which is in the best interest of its citizens and the town;		
NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JOHNSTON HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:		
Section 1: The language set forth in the Johnston Code concerning nuisance is deleted in its entirety and is replaced by the following language for nuisances in "Exhibit A".		
<u>Section 2:</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give the provisions of this ordinance full force and effect.
