 - 14-17 year olds (1300 words). 1st: \$750, 2nd: \$500, 3rd: \$250 (Total: \$1500)
- ★ Overall winner: The essay that leaves the greatest impression and reflects the greatest learning experience. \$5,000
- ★ Honorable mentions (everyone who does not win a prize): \$50 (Total: \$150)
- ★ Total prizes: \$8,550 (\$8,100)
