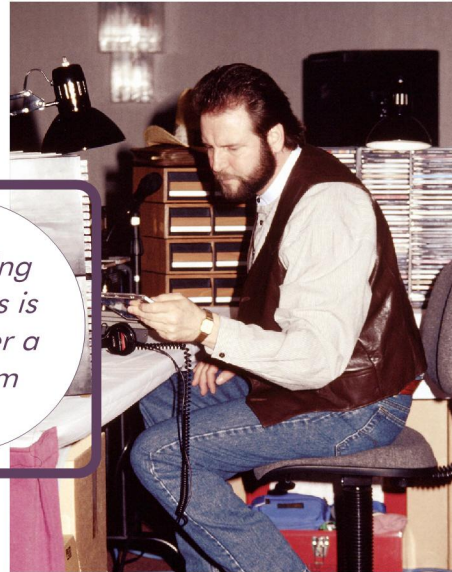
Student Applications

A Journey Thru Education is proud of the relationships we have formed with dozens of Public, Private and Charter schools all over the continental United States.

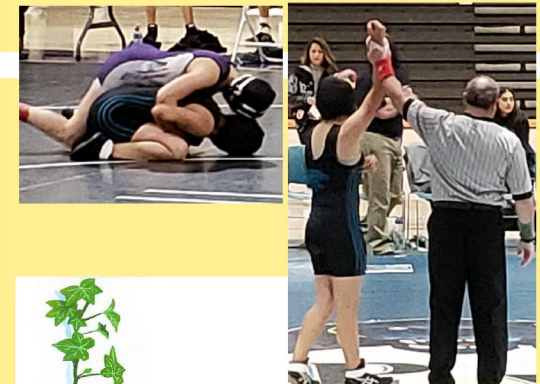
