The Survey


- Joint project of the Ohio Legislative Black Caucus Foundation and The University of Akron Ray C. Bliss Institute of Applied Politics.
- Random sample of 1,500 adult black Ohioans, with telephone (landline and cell phone) and online components, weighted by U.S. Census data.
- Conducted in December 2019 and January 2020, Margin of Error: plus or minus two percentage points
- Focus on issue priorities and attitudes





Thinking about police protection in Ohio, which of the statements comes closest to your view?







Thinking about abortion in Ohio, which statement comes closest to your view?





Thinking about health care in Ohio, which of the following statments comes closest to your view?




Thinking of environmental protection in Ohio, which of the statements is closest to your view?










Thinking about public assistance in Ohio, which of the statements comes closest to your views?








