The purposes of the troop committee are to ensure that:

- The troop has a quality program, under capable leadership.
- The troop achieves the purposes of the chartered organization and the Boy Scouts of America.



Scoutmaster

- Trains and guides boy leaders
- Uses the methods of Scouting to achieve the aims of scouting
- Provides a summarized annual calendar and a detailed 3-month calendar to the committee

Chartered Organization

Chartered Organization Representative (COR)

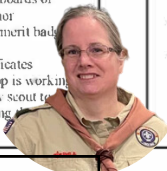
- Help select the right leadership for the unit
- Encourage leaders to be trained
- Promote well planned unit programs
- Encourage the committee to hold regular meetings
- Encourage recognition of leaders

Committee Chairman

- Organize the committee to see that all functions are delegated, coordinated, and completed
- Maintain a close relationship with the COR and the scoutmaster
- Prepare troop committee meetings
- Arrange for charter review and re-charter annually

Advancement Coordinator

- Encourage Scouts to advance in rank
- Maintain all scout advancement records
- Arrange quarterly troop boards of review and courts of honor
- Develop and maintain a merit badge counselor list
- Secure badges and certificates
- Help ensure that the troop is working toward helping each new scout to reach the First Class rank during the year



Outdoor/Activities Coordinator

- Help secure permission to use camping sites
- Serve as the transportation coordinator
- Promote the National Camping Award
- Promote, through family meetings, attendance at troop camporees, and summer camps to reach the goal of 100% attendance



Secretary

- Keep minutes of the troop committee meeting
- Prepare a family newsletter or website of troop events and activities
- Conduct the troop resource survey
- Maintain up-to-date health and medical record forms for all members and leader of the troop
- Report the minutes of the meeting



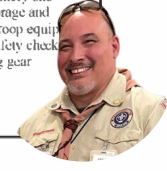
Treasurer

- Help the troop plan, budget, and account for troop funds
- Maintain the unit's checking and savings accounts
- Supervise money-earning projects, including obtaining proper authorizations
- Lead the Friends of Scouting



Equipment Coordinator

- Supervise and help the troop procure camping equipment
- Maintain an inventory and ensure proper storage and maintenance of troop equipment
- Make periodic safety checks on all troop camping gear



Fundraiser Coordinator

- Responsible for fundraising
- Be responsible for planning fundraising events
- Transfer all monies to treasurer in a timely manner with appropriate receipts
- Responsible to for all monies collected at fund raises



All Committee Members should:

- Support Troop efforts to raise money.
- Seek out and suggest opportunities, activities and projects.
- Encourage Troop members to wear uniforms.
- Occasionally be involved in Troop meetings and activities to get to know Troop members.
- Serve as Consultants or Merit Badge Counselors when needed.
- Other responsibilities as needed.

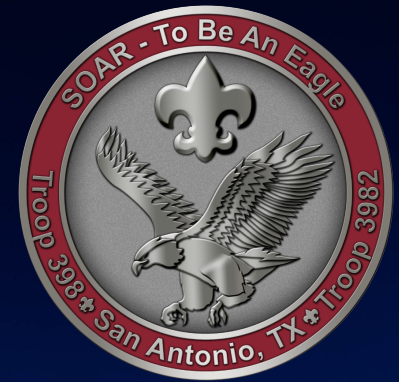

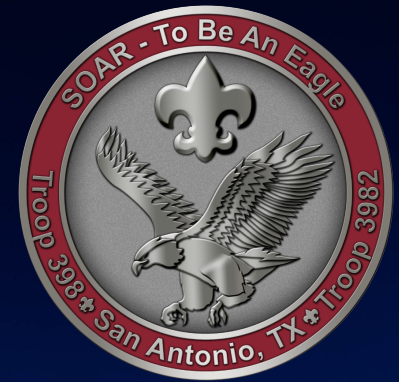
