## Day by Day Itinerary

**Sun., October 9 – CHICAGO / EN ROUTE** (I) We depart Chicago's O'Hare International Airport by scheduled non-stop service on the overnight transatlantic flight to Dublin, Ireland.

Mon., October 10 – DUBLIN / WATERFORD (B,D) After landing at Dublin Airport our Driver/Guide, Patrick Foley, will welcome us to Ireland. Our day begins with a traditional Irish breakfast where we'll have the opportunity to have our first genuine pint of Guinness in Ireland. Then we'll journey south into County Wicklow, the Garden of Ireland, where we'll visit the early Christian settlement ofough. The "glen of the two lakes" is a truly spellbinding place, founded by St. Kevin the 6th century. Continuing




south into County Wexford, we'll visit The Dunbrody, an authentic reproduction of an 1840's sailing ship. Together with their world class exhibition, it is an educational living museum of Irish History that will tell you everything you need to know about life for emigrants during the Irish famine. Afterward, we'll end our day in County Waterford, in the City of Waterford, located at the head of Waterford Harbour.

## Tues., October 11 – WATERFORD

**(B)** 

Today we'll enjoy an Epic Tour of the Viking Triangle, where our guide will bring us through the streets and buildings of 1100 years of Waterford's history from the Vikings to the Victorians, in Ireland's oldest city, Waterford. And of course our time here wouldn't be complete without a visit to the world famous Waterford Crystal. Crossing back into County Wexford, we'll visit Hook Head to see the world's oldest operating lighthouse. Along the way, we'll stop to see Loftus Hall, said by locals to have been haunted by the devil and the ghost of a young woman.

Wed., October 12 – WATERFORD / KINSALE (B,D) Today we depart Waterford and make a stop to view the impressive Lismore Castle, currently the Irish



home of the Duke of Devonshire. Crossing into County Cork, we'll stop at Midleton Distillery for a tour and tasting. Nearby, we'll see the beautiful Kindred Spirits sculpture, a tribute to the incredible generosity the Choctaw Nation showed the Irish people during the Great Famine. Then we're headed to the port town of Cobh, the last stop for the Titanic before its doomed Atlantic crossing in 1912, where we'll visit the Cobh Heritage Centre tracing the history of emigration from Ireland to the United States. Our day will end as we make our way to Kinsale, the beginning (or end, depending on the direction you're headed!) of the Wild Atlantic Way, where we'll enjoy dinner and a bit of music from Ian this evening.

## Thurs., October 13 – KINSALE

(**B**,L)

Today we'll get to know Kinsale on a relaxed but highly focused food stroll with an engaging and experienced guide. We'll go to places that are off the usual food route where tastings are generous and the people lively. Cork people are enormously proud of their food and quite rightly! We'll also see the 9/11 Memorial, Garden of Remembrance, honoring the 343 firefighters who lost their lives on 9/11 - a very moving experience. Then we'll visit Charles Fort, a star-shaped military fortress that has stood firm for centuries. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore Ireland's Foodie Capital and its many wonderful pubs and restaurants.

Fri., October 14 – KINSALE / KILLARNEY (B,D) After breakfast our journey today takes us into Cork City where after a brief introductory tour we'll enjoy some free time to explore on our own - be sure to visit the famous English Market in the center of the city, and its many quaint laneways and pubs. Afterwards we'll travel to Blarney for a visit to fabled Blarney Castle. Here you'll have an opportunity to climb the steps of the fortress and kiss the world famous Blarney Stone. We'll also visit the Blarney Woolen Mills, the largest Irish crafts store in the country. Leaving County Cork, we'll enter the Kingdom of Kerry on our path to Killarney, our home for the next couple of nights. We'll enjoy dinner and a performance from Ian at the famous Danny Mann Pub.

### Sat., October 15– KILLARNEY

**(B)** 

Today we explore the Dingle Peninsula, the westernmost part of Ireland that juts out into the Atlantic and contains some of the most ancient and traditional aspects of Irish culture. We'll end with time to enjoy the thriving fishing port of Dingle - be sure to try the chowder that County Kerry is famous for! Returning to Killarney, the remainder of the day is free to explore, or perhaps enjoy a jaunting car tour.

## Sun., October 16 – KILLARNEY / DUBLIN (B)

After breakfast we travel through Ireland's Golden Vale to County Tipperary where we'll visit the Rock of Cashel, a symbol of royal and priestly power for more than a millennium. Leaving Cashel, we'll continue through the beautiful Irish countryside as we make our way to the capital city of Dublin. We'll visit the Guinness Storehouse to see exhibits on how this world-famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today, and finish our visit in the rooftop bar, Gravity, overlooking the city center



where you can sample a draft Guinness and enjoy the view. Then we'll check into our hotel, and the evening is free to enjoy the atmosphere at one of Dublin's many restaurants and pubs.

## Mon., October 17 – DUBLIN

#### (**B**,**D**)

After breakfast we'll embark on a brief city tour as we make our way to the Irish National War Memorial Gardens, where we can walk along the banks of the River Liffey and enjoy the stunning scenery. In stark contrast, we'll visit (dependent on availability) the historic Kilmainham Gaol, where the leaders of the 1916 Uprising were executed. We'll also have the opportunity to walk across the road to the beautiful gardens of the Royal Hospital, now the Irish Museum of Modern Art. As we begin our return to the hotel, we'll stop at Pearse Lyons Distillery, built in the beautifully restored Church of St. James in Dublin's historic Liberties, where we'll enjoy a tour and whiskey tasting. Afterward, we'll



return to our hotel and prepare for tonight's Hooley at Taylor's Three Rock, a night full of traditional Irish music, dancing and likely a song or two from Ian himself!

**Tues., October 18 – DUBLIN / CHICAGO** (B,I) All too soon, our time in Ireland has come to the end. We transfer to Dublin Airport in plenty of time to check in for our non-stop flight to Chicago.
