

We provide clinic-based speech pathology services for:

#### **Speech Sounds**

Children who have difficulties saying sounds or speaking clearly due to:

- Phonological delays or disorders
- Articulation delays or disorders
- Motor speech delays or disorders, including Childhood Apraxia of Speech

#### **Stuttering**

Children who stutter or are dysfluent when they talk

#### **Expressive Language**

Young children who are late to talk

Children, prior to Kinder, who have semantic difficulties, difficulties formulating sentences with the appropriate structure and/or grammar difficulties

#### **Receptive Language**

Children, prior to Kinder, who have difficulties understanding conversation or following directions

#### **Literacy/Phonological Awareness**

Children with difficulties identifying and/or manipulating sounds to support reading and spelling

# Our Service Delivery Philosophy



Our services are family focused. This means that everything we do is focused towards meeting the goals and needs of our clients and their family. We work collaboratively with families to increase a child's ability to communicate effectively. We aim to provide individualised, culturally responsive, and evidence-based interventions for each family, that supports children to develop their functional skills in everyday environments.

We acknowledge that **children** are able to express their own needs and worries, but also **support family members** as advocates and decision makers for their child.

We understand that families have **different communication needs**, and regularly checking that the intended message has been clearly communicated is vital. We support communication through alternative methods such as providing information verbally and in written form, using interpreters and/or using assistive technology. We respect **communication as a two-way process**, and listen to our client's needs, goals, aspirations and feedback to inform our practice.

We have a **culture of continuous improvement** and we welcome feedback from our clients at any time. We use this feedback to direct quality improvement activities and the strategic direction of the organisation.



## Support & Mentoring



#### **Induction Program**

We make time for you to complete our induction program when you start working with us. We think that it is important to set aside time to teach you everything you need to know about our practice, our clients and the way we work.

#### **Clinical Meetings**

Team members all have the opportunity to present cases or discuss clinical areas at our regular clinical meetings. These meetings are a great opportunity to problem solve together and improve our clinical knowledge and therefore, clinical outcomes for clients.

#### **Clinical Supervision**

Every speech pathologist meets regularly with their dedicated supervisor or peer support group to discuss clients, ask clinical questions and develop our clinical knowledge.

These meetings are booked and prioritised for the entire year.

#### **Professional Development**

We support team members to achieve their learning and development goals through independent learning and attendance at formal workshops/ events.

We support you financially with course fees and paid time to attend.

#### **Informal Support**

We acknowledge the need for information sharing and discussions throughout each day, so we set realistic workloads to allow the team to have time to do this!

#### **Clinic Support Officer**

Our outstanding clinic support officer provides administrative support to our practice, enabling you to focus on providing exceptional services to our clients.

Provides leadership, supervision and mentoring to the clinical team. Works with the Directors to improve clinical practice and service delivery.




Principal

## Rewards Program

Be financially rewarded for helping more clients

In addition to our **above Award base salary**, our **Rewards Program** offers you the ability to boost your wage every fortnight by helping more clients.

Commencing after your 6 month probation period, our rewards are based on an increasing commission percentage.

The graph below compares the required *Health Professional and Support Services Award* (HPSS) salary, *Capital Therapy Services' base salary* and the total *reward salary available* when 50% of your time is spent directly with clients.

Superannuation is paid in addition to your base salary and rewards payments.

#### **Flexible Work Hours**


We work with you to distribute your working hours in a way that works for you, whether that might be having an early departure on Friday's or every second Wednesday off.

#### **Telehealth**

We provide Telehealth consultations for clients outside of lockdown times too! It's a great way to help clients continue to attend appointments when they can't make it to the clinic, and it helps families attend more frequently for programs such as ReST.

#### **Computers & iPads**

Each speech pathologist has access to their own computer and an iPad with an ever increasing number of apps to support their clinical work.

#### **Cloud Based Software**

Our Practice Management Software and practice documents are all cloud based, enabling electronic notes, calendar and file access by the whole team, easily from anywhere (although we encourage you to keep work at work!)
