Puppies are exposed to real-world experiences (sounds, surfaces, grooming, leash training) long before joining their new families.


We work on crate, loose-leash, grooming/clipping/face/nails training and get our puppies used to cars, noise, children and other environents outside of the home.



Barkley and I had our first hair cut at the groomer this week and I am feeling much cooler already!







Buddy


I am an 11-week-old Cobberdog and currently weigh around 4 kg.



During class time we found that learning can be really tricky sometimes, but we kept practicing our commands and now we can do so many new things!














