Life" – my response, that religion is "full of it." Dump it.


And, the second largest religion, Islam, teaches that our Creator inspired sin in the human race.

Without filled pews and empty pocket-books by their constituents, religion, none of them, would be with us today which leaves only one path before we inhale our last breath - Yahweh.


