#### **FORWARD**

Sinai, set in motion truth, instruction for life, reward and punishment for obedience and disobedience and outlined the truth about where we end up in death. It isn't in Heaven (the sky), it's in the soil of the ground of which He created his first male

human being, Adam. "You were made from dust, and to dust you will return." **Genesis 3:19** 

So, when you hear people say as they mourn the death of a loved one, "he or she is in a better place" or perhaps "he or she is looking down on me" or "I talk with he or she all the time" or "I'll be with he or she soon", and there's even one religion that believes not only do they go to heaven, but for the men that die, there's a harem of virgins waiting for them, don't listen.

It's all malarky, all a made-up lie to sooth your brain which in turn relaxes your body in a mesmerizing fashion. You can do the same thing with Yoga which proves, "it's all in the mind."

Not that our Heavenly Father isn't alive and well, isn't paying attention, isn't caring, but, He hasn't acted yet. The greatest miracle since creation will be when He raises bodies up from the dust of the earth, puts them back together (lock, stock and barrel), breaths the breath of life in to our lungs and the body lives again, this time forever. Believing that, we are scattered, not congregated. We stand alone, but, we believe and we invite you to join a journey that's eternal in scope and rewarding in reality as you become a friend of our Heavenly Father, our Creator.

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#### FATHERS' HEAVEN

Residents of Heaven today are obviously the Creator of the Universe and His Heavenly Army (*His angels*). Defined:

The heavens belong to Yahweh, but he has given the earth to all humanity. **Psalm 115:16** 

There are two human beings unaccounted for. Elijah (whom He took off the surface of the earth in a whirlwind) and Enoch (who just disappeared).

Elijah will be resurrected in the final days just before the beginning of everlasting life.

Elijah's physical departure is recorded:

"As they were walking along and talking, suddenly a chariot of fire appeared, drawn by horses of fire. It drove between the two men, separating them, and Elijah was carried by a whirlwind into heaven (the sky)." **2 Kings 2:11** 

Then we find him coming back again: "Look, I am sending you the prophet Elijah before the great and dreadful day of Yahweh arrives". **Malachi 4:5** 

Elijah was a great preacher/teacher and prophet in his day, but still has duties associated with renewing relationships just before the Father purges the earth and continues everlasting life. We constantly hear folks referring to "up there" and "looking down" in discussions about people who have expired, especially close relatives or spouses. As upsetting as this might be, no one is "up there" "looking down." They are not in Heaven, they are in death.

Death is the temporary waiting condition for all people. Dead and buried bodies will be raised up and reconstructed with one of two results:

- 1. Everlasting Life
- 2. Shame And Everlasting Disgrace. **Daniel 12:2**

No one is "in Heaven". They are all "in death ." Through Daniel our Creator defined the state of death of our personalities (souls):

"As for you, go your way until the end. You will rest, and then at the end of the days, you will rise again to receive the inheritance set aside for you." Daniel 12:13

In that day, everyone in the land of Judah will sing this song:

Our city is strong! We are surrounded by the walls of Heavenly Father's salvation. Open the gates to <u>all who are righteous</u>; allow the faithful to enter. Not all who are religious, all who are righteous.

You will keep in perfect peace all <u>who trust in you</u>, all whose <u>thoughts are fixed on you</u>! Trust in Yahweh always, for Yahweh our Heavenly Father is the eternal Rock. He humbles the proud and brings down the arrogant city. He brings it down to the dust. The poor and oppressed trample it underfoot, and the needy walk all over it.

But for <u>those who are righteous</u>, the way is not steep and rough. You are a Heavenly Father who does what is right, and you smooth out the path ahead of them. Yahweh, we <u>show our trust</u> <u>in you</u> by <u>obeying your laws</u>; our heart's desire is to <u>glorify your name</u>.

All night long I search for you; in the morning I earnestly seek for Heavenly Father. For only when you come to judge the earth will people learn what is right. Your kindness to the wicked does not make them do good. Although others do right, the wicked keep doing wrong and take no notice of Yahweh's majesty. O Yahweh, they pay no attention to your upraised fist. Show them your eagerness to defend your people. Then they will be ashamed. Let your fire consume your enemies.

Yahweh, you will grant us peace; all we have accomplished is really from you. O Yahweh our Heavenly Father, others have ruled us, but **you alone are the one we worship**. Those we served before are dead and gone. Their departed spirits *(personalities)* 

will never return! You attacked them and destroyed them, and they are long forgotten.

O Yahweh, you have made our nation great; yes, you have made us great. You have extended our borders, and we give you the glory! Yahweh, in distress we searched for you. We prayed beneath the burden of your discipline. Just as a pregnant woman writhes and cries out in pain as she gives birth, so were we in your presence, Yahweh. We, too, writhe in agony, but nothing comes of our suffering. We have not given salvation to the earth, nor brought life into the world.

But those who die in Yahweh will live; their bodies will rise again! Those who sleep in the earth will rise up and sing for joy!

For your <u>life-giving light</u> will fall like dew on your people in the place of the dead!

Go home, my people, and lock your doors! Hide yourselves for a little while until Yahweh's anger has passed. Look! Yahweh is coming from heaven to punish the people of the earth for their sins. The earth will no longer hide those who have been killed. They will be brought out for all to see. **Isaiah 26** 

The <u>wicked will go down</u> to the grave. This is the fate of all the nations who ignore the Heavenly Father (of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob). Psalm 9:17

For the nations that refuse to serve you will be destroyed. **Isaiah 60:12** 

They will live safely in Israel and build homes and plant vineyards. And when I punish the neighboring nations that treated them with contempt, they will know that I am Yahweh their Heavenly Father." **Ezekiel 28:6** 

To summarize then, bodies stop breathing and "turn to dust". Souls *(personalities)* rest in "death", not in Heaven.

When the Father's plan is complete, those bodes raise again (and are obviously rebuilt - See newsletter #77 "He Will Put Us Back Together Again") and the Father's judgement is initiated to place an individual into a state of eternal life in Israel (for the Jew and the foreigner who trusts the Father entirely).

Then there is eternal life in a "believing" nation, eternal life in an "opposing" nation. and life in a pit in the earth where the worm that is supposed to devour flesh never devours it but continually eats away at it, and the body lives in an everlasting flame of heat that never goes out.

Nothing comes "down from heaven."

A quick comparison is the building of the ark. Yahweh laid out the plan, it took Noah (and his family) a strong part of their lives to build it to fulfill the proclamation that the Father would flood the earth and kill everyone on it.

If there was mysticism involved, why didn't the Father mystically drop the ark out of the sky for Noah instead of having him take a good part of his life to build it?

If there were a mystical city coming out of the sky, why would the Father have His nation *(the Jew)* rebuild both the city of Jerusalem and the Temple for Him to reside in?

The Father has <u>always</u> used earthly elements and materials in His miracles, and He has <u>always</u> used man to construct. Even the ark of the covenant, as Holy as that element was to house the

book of the law, wasn't built by Yahweh. It was designed by Him, but built by man.

We certainly understand, there are over 2 billion people on earth right now that have their hopes set on some huge city coming down out of the sky that their new testament has described and their pastors and priests have taught for centuries.

If you believe Yahweh, and you believe Yahweh's prophets, you'll soon discover it's all fabricated to deceive people into thinking they don't have to do anything to honor the Father of Creation. Just believe in some mystical "son-god" (who can't even be proven historically to have existed), and some mystical city, and forget all of the commandments, decrees and instructions for life set forth by the Heavenly Father.

#### **OBEDIENCE**

For that, He will provide a rich store of salvation, wisdom and knowledge. Nothing religion can offer, and especially match.

Some of us will be His ambassadors going out from Israel into the nations remaining on earth who He doesn't destroy, and not only will we represent Him, we will be charged with the responsibility to make sure the nations are abiding by His rules. For, He says if they aren't He will hold back the rain and they won't have crops to eat.

Some of us will also be healing ambassadors using the leaves from the trees that grow continual fruit for our livelihood to "heal nations" with.

We will be living ON earth. Alas, there will be those who He does NOT rescue from death, and they will go on down in to the grave, and the pit which is IN earth and He's already demonstrated how that works centuries ago:

And Moses said, "This is how you will know that Yahweh has sent me to do all these things that I have done — for I have not done them on my own. If these men die a natural death, or if

He (Moses) had hardly finished speaking the words when the ground suddenly split open beneath them. The earth opened its mouth and swallowed the men, along with their households and all their followers who were standing with them, and everything they owned.

So <u>they went down alive into the grave</u>, along with all their belongings. The earth closed over them, and they all vanished from among the people of Israel. All the people around them fled when they heard their screams. "The earth will swallow us, too!" they cried. Then fire blazed forth from Yahweh and burned up the 250 men who were offering incense. **Numbers 16:31-35** 

That served as a warning to Israel at that time and most certainly should serve as a warning now.

If we expire before He brings us home to Israel, we trust Him to rescue us from the state of death, because we do understand, death can be swallowed up by the grave, and in to the pit - FOREVER.

That's reserved for those who DON'T fear the Heavenly Father, and DON'T maintain His commandments, decrees and instructions for life, but instead mock those instructions and listen to a lie about some son-god savior, and other mystical, religious teachings about someone, anyone, other than Yahweh, our Father, Creator.

Commit everything you do to Yahweh. <u>Trust him</u>, and He will help you. He will make your innocence radiate like the dawn, and the justice of your cause will shine like the noonday sun.

Be still in the presence of Yahweh, and <u>wait patiently for Him</u> <u>to act</u>. Don't worry about evil people who prosper or fret about their wicked schemes.

Stop being angry! Turn from your rage! Do not lose your temper — it only leads to harm. For the wicked will be destroyed, but those who trust in Yahweh will possess the land.

Soon the wicked will disappear. Though you look for them, they will be gone. The lowly will possess the land and will live in peace and prosperity.

The wicked plot against the righteous; they snarl at them in defiance. But Yahweh just laughs, for he sees their day of judgment coming.

The wicked draw their swords and string their bows to kill the poor and the oppressed, to slaughter those who do right. But their swords will stab their own hearts, and their bows will be broken.

It is <u>better to be righteous</u> and have little than to be evil and rich. For the strength of the wicked will be shattered, but <u>Yahweh</u> takes care of the righteous.

Day by day Yahweh takes care of the innocent, and they will receive an inheritance that lasts forever. They will not be disgraced in hard times; even in famine they will have more than enough.

But the wicked will die. Yahweh's enemies are like flowers in a field — they will disappear like smoke.

The wicked borrow and never repay, but the righteous are generous givers. Those Yahweh blesses will possess the land, but those He curses will die.

Yahweh directs the steps of the righteous. He delights in every detail of their lives. Though they stumble, they will never fall, for Yahweh holds them by the hand.

Once I was young, and now I am old. Yet I have never seen the righteous abandoned or their children begging for bread. The righteous always give generous loans to others, and their children are a blessing. <u>Turn from evil</u> and <u>do good</u>, and you will live in the land forever. For Yahweh loves justice, and <u>He will never abandon the</u> righteous.

He will keep them safe forever, but the children of the wicked will die. The righteous will possess the land and will live there forever.

The righteous offer good counsel; they teach right from wrong. They have **made Heavenly Father's law their own**, so they will never slip from his path.

The wicked wait in ambush for the righteous, looking for an excuse to kill them. But Yahweh will not let the wicked succeed or let the righteous be condemned when they are put on trial.

Put your hope in Yahweh. Travel steadily along his path. He will honor you by giving you the land. You will see the wicked destroyed.

I have seen wicked and ruthless people flourishing like a tree in its native soil. But when I looked again, they were gone!

Though I searched for them, I could not find them!

Look at those who are **honest** and **good**, for a wonderful future awaits those who love peace. But the rebellious will be destroyed; they have no future.

Yahweh rescues the righteous; He is their fortress in times of trouble. Yahweh helps them, rescuing them from the wicked. He saves them, and they find shelter in him.

#### Therein resides instructions for our lives friends.

A huge part of life is outlined just in this one Psalm let alone all the rest of the instructions from our Heavenly Father in the rest of His word from Genesis to Malachi.

So, death is not an immediate pathway to Yahweh. It's a resting place that He has allowed to exist from the day Adam decided to rebel against Him and cause death to enter existence.

Your family, your friends and eventually yourself, (that is your individual personality, your soul, or everything about you) will rest and wait.

Your body will begin to turn to dust during that waiting time and then eventually, just like He did at the flood, He will intervene in His created human existence, raise us up, put us all back together, breath the breath of life into our lungs and judge us individually for things that are outlined in this Psalm and it is those actions that will set the stage for our eternal existence.
