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# **FORWARD**

NE of the most important facets of the human race to understand is that we are created human beings from a Creator, not evolvements. We didn't just fall out of the sky like a rain drop and evolve into the 206 bones, 900 ligaments, millions and millions of tiny protein filaments that make up more than 600 muscles, 7 trillion nerve cells, lungs that process 75 million gallons of air in a lifetime, a cardiovascular system that carries oxygen from the air He created into the blood stream and through vital organs that process and use it made up of our heart, lungs, veins, arteries, kidneys and liver. He further exampled entire nations and their descendants for up to ten generations whom He exempted from His realm of created existence when He banned Ammonites and Moabites from assembling in His presence. "No Ammonite or Moabite or any of their descendants for ten generations may be admitted to the assembly of Yahweh." **Deuteronomy 23:3** 

It's simple to see then, generational consequences are a fact of life, and that's the decision of our Creator, Yahweh, not you or I. But, it is without saying, obedience lies at the basis of prevention just as repentance is the turning point of acceptance of His Righteous standards.

Are we perfect? Absolutely not.

Why do you suppose there was in place during His Temple/ Priestly realm of life on earth, a system of sin sacrificial steps to be taken, some personal, some national to correct errors in judgement or just forgetfulness in the acts and actions of His chosen nation (thus all who believe Him). He knows we are not perfect. He knows we err.

He IS our Creator, thus our life, and there is no other nor is there any other way to gain the reward of eternal life (thus eternal bliss in His presence) without the basis of life, obedience to His Created law and order.

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### 1. LET'S GET REAL

Sure, people die in all sorts of fashions and their bodies deteriorate, some buried, some drowned, some cremated, or just blown up by a bomb while defending a nation. But, we die, our bones begin to deteriorate to dust and our personalities rest in death as He described to us. "As for you (Daniel), go your way until the end. You will rest, and then at the end of the days, you will rise again to receive the inheritance set aside for you." Daniel 12:13. "You have rescued me from death; you have kept my feet from slipping. Yahweh's heaven does not contain flesh and blood humans. It contains He and His angels and as impossible as it is to completely comprehend, He and His angels have always existed, always.
