For a quarter century, the relationship we've developed with Yahweh has been one of growth, development and His influence (Spirit) applying the words He gave to the world at Mt. Sinai and then through Moses and subsequent Influentially filled prophets. Realizing we are part of the **scattered** and in His timing, we now share with you what we have come to know, encouraging you to come directly to Him and not religion.

Early on, we were caught up in religion, many of them, and in our stubbornness, it took a while for our eyes to be opened to the man-made evil and corruption that even religion presents itself to be when fully exposed. Eventually just like His rescue of Israel, and in our submission like those of Nineveh, He pulled us out of it and we've never looked back.

We believe Him when He says He will gather us up from around the world. If dead, He will put us back together and bring us to Israel where we'll spend eternity with Him and that includes the Jew and every foreigner *(non-Jew)* who believes.

We are a "Scattered Community" and we invite you to join in on a journey that's eternal in scope and rewarding in reality as you become a friend of Heavenly Father, Yahweh.

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1. CREATOR AND CREATION

CAUGHT up in a survival mentality from the least of the knowledgable to the brilliance of the greatest minds on earth, it makes no difference when it comes to the nature of the beast. We all bleed red blood, we are all created with the same basic structure of cells that define us as human beings yet set us apart from other animal, plant and mineral life that make up our world, and we all evolved from one man and one woman.

And then there is this god thing, and I use that term with mute emphasis because in our world today, there are so many of them their importance is too controversial and so battle-ground relevant to mass hysteria including war, I prefer not to use that term at all. So henceforth He isn't god, He is our Heavenly Father.

At the basis of the worldly description of someone above us lies a huge part of the divisional make up of world governments and world societies that have created the confusion and holier-than-thou attitudes that separate us one from another and in a quarter of a century with Him, we've concluded that we are one on one with creation and forced into governed societies that have little to do with any of it.

Evolving out of the mess is an entity called religion, a definition of "the belief and worship of a superhuman power, especially a personal god or gods." At last count, there are an estimated 4,200 of these entities in the world today that 7.6 billion

people, currently alive on earth, are faced with making a decision about which one is right for them, or if any at all. Then one has to consider the roughly 108 billion humans who have lived and already died since time began, and the individual decision—making is massive to say the least. We might add here, the earlier population numbers are pure conjecture because no one really knows for sure.

Sampling some of these religions, my wife and I have concluded that none of them offer a resolve about our flesh and blood relationship with creation, and our belief in a Creator of that creation, so we set upon a path to discover the relationship between the Creator and His Created and here's what we have concluded:

Our Creator is a Heavenly Father of miraculous capabilities and He has a name He gave Moses, Yahweh (I have caused to be); He and His angels have always existed; this universe, our world and all of its components (including human beings) exist because of His own personal desires; and our relationship with Him is one on one with no need for a mediator on our behalf.

He did not create religion, He created life and He gave us instructions on how to live life to glorify His miraculous intent for a relationship that can be forever, which is a choice He has left up to each of us to make.

We found His instructions for life through the lifestyles and writings passed down through particular people He chose on earth to represent His desires, not the least of which were ancestors of His chosen nation, Israel. Thus we believe and are fully committed to the Heavenly Father of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and His chosen nation Israel, and no religion.

Not religionists, but believers and encourage you to understand that you can take the path of an eternal relationship with the one who created you, be you alive or when you die, recovered and reconstructed from the world of evil and corruption we now have to endure. You need no religion to get you there, you just need faith, trust, love and obedience and you'll have His attention.

He created us for Him, not Him for us. We are His creation waiting for salvation and He is the Creator holding it in His hands.

2. LIFE IS SO SHORT

IFE is such a short journey when compared to the time of creation. Awed by the immensity of the universe and the minuteness of the molecules that make up our bodies, we find that to our Creator, life is as nothing. Everyone is but a breath, even to those who seem secure (Psalm 39:5).

Every one of us as individuals are as different as night and day and it matters not where we live, what our nationality might be, the color of our skin, or the language we speak, because we all evolved from the same created source of one man and one woman with one objective, love for the One who created us.

All too often the human race in its reach to justify existence, forgets there is just a very very short period of time from our miraculous conception, our first breath of life at birth to our last breath of life at expiration and in that short space of time, we make a decision about the eternal side of existence. That is the realm, eternity, where Yahweh, our Heavenly Father, and His angels have resided forever. Our short 70-odd-years or so of life is over in a flash and its in that short period of time you and I must decide eternity.

That's right, we decide eternity and no one else. While we can be guided and taught, hopefully by parents who understand our Heavenly Father, no one can decide eternal life for us. No one can stand in our place to make the decision for us and no one

As you absorb this information, please realize that you are your own judge in the decisions you make about your relationship with Yahweh, our Heavenly Father and we write this with the sincere hope that you will seek the path back to Him from the **scattered** condition you now find yourself living on this planet.

However, He also said, at the **scattering**, there are those who would yet honor Him, cling to Him, love Him, obey Him to the best of their human capability and wait patiently for His return to earth to gather His **scattered** for all eternity, to live with Him in righteousness forever in Israel (*read newsletter #289*).

If you love Him, if you care about Him, if you care about yourself and where you will end up in eternity, you belong with the "Scattered Community" and you need to stand your ground against all odds, and to help you, we want to introduce you to or bring you back to Yahweh, our Heavenly Father, who will judge all

of us, good and bad when that time comes. No religion and no government can give you a chance at eternal life with Yahweh. Only you!

The "Scattered Community" is not a religion. It is not a government. It is a community of people who individually believe in a Heavenly Father who offers a path to Him without need of a religion or a government to guide them. It is a community of people who sense in their soul, the world and it's 195 governments and it's estimated 4,200 religions are not the answer. Yahweh is the answer, so we encourage you to embrace the community and live His way before you take that last breath and return back to the dust of the earth from which you were created.

We once again encourage you to think about yourself and the time of life you have in your body, because life is so short. On earth, 55.3 million people die every year, that's 151,600 people every day and 6,316 people every hour, and you have from the time you inhaled your first breath to the time you exhale your last breath to make your decision about your eternal life.

Life is so, so short.

3. CHOICE

BELIVING the writings of Yahweh, and His chosen representatives such as Moses and a barrage of prophets, you'll find the nature of your Heavenly Father at work on earth. Those writings are contained in what man refers to as the "Old Testament" and in those writings we find Yahweh manifested on earth as He set out to direct His human creation on how they should live life. Throughout those writings the action of choice to obey Him or not obey Him manifests itself as an individual and collective decision by those with a mind capable of doing so, and it began with Adam and Eve.

We don't refer to His title as "god" because that is a referral too often used by too many religions that encompass too many beliefs and systems that we've come to learn are just not of Him at all.

We don't refer to His name as "lord" because that too is a referral too often used by too many religions that encompass too many beliefs and systems that we've come to learn are just not of Him at all.

We do not believe in the "New Testament" of instructions for life because those mythical writings center themselves around a figure other than Yahweh as the world's savior and we believe His words when He says He is the only savior and there is no other. *I, Yahweh, am your Savior and your Redeemer, the Mighty One of*

Israel - (Isaiah 60:16). I am Yahweh your Heavenly Father, and there is no other - (Joel 2:27)

We reference the Word of our Heavenly Father in the Biblical interpretation of The New Living Translation, Genesis to Malachi which holds the truth about His desires for our life from beginning to end. It's for all of us, and easily understood.

We do not believe in any religion. Common sense tells us that of an estimated 4,200 religions on earth, none follow life as He laid it down for us to live at Mount Sinai and instead have perverted the true Word of our Heavenly Father for their own gain. We promote no religion, we are not involved in any religious rite or church, but instead in awe and respect of our Heavenly Father we worship Him right where we stand at all times.

We observe His Sabbath, a day out of each week to rest as it is an instruction from Him, and common sense suggests it's a necessity.

We observe His Passover Season in obedience, honor and respect of the miraculous salvation of His chosen nation, Israel, because in that miraculous act, He showed the world what salvation is all about. Those who paid the price for trying to stop Him, and those who were protected for obeying Him.

We honor Him in other Feasts that He set aside to give Him thanks for provision and sustenance of life, for rain, for crops, for the nourishing foods we eat. We honor Him for His creation, we worship Him for even thinking about us after the flood, and we credit Him for being a true Father concerned about our needs, and aiding us in our endeavors to worship and obey Him.

Those choices set us apart, make us unique and in the midst of the 7.6 billion people on earth, **scattered** as we are, we anticipate with great awe and praise, the day He returns to earth, gathers us from around the world (including the graves we'll occupy) and brings us to His land of milk and honey where we'll spend eternity with Him.

<u>Scattered</u> as we are, we know there are others all over the world and we reach to you to encourage you if you are Jew to return to Him and His ways of life, and if you're not, know that as you believe, you will participate as a believer in the greatest miracle of all time, raised and refurbished for eternal existence.

Know this, no one goes to heaven. Everyone dies and returns to dust and the personality rests. Heaven is Yahweh's abode along with His angels and they've been there forever (read newsletter #48).

We believe He exists in a universe far outside of our own because He created our universe. Common sense then tells us He couldn't have existed in something that didn't exist before it was created. In other words, He is the Creator, not the created.

Know this too, He knows everything that is going on in this world, and He knows every individual that has lived and lives in it. Know that He is watching, **scattered** as we are, He's watching our choices. From heaven Yahweh looks down and sees all mankind - (Psalm 33:13) He views the ends of the earth and sees everything under the heavens. - (Job 28:24)

He has millions and millions of angels that serve Him and guard us at His beckoning command: "He will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways" - (**Psalm 91:11**) We can think of no better protection in all the world than angels commanded by our Heavenly Father to watch over us (read newsletter #162).

You may raise the question about where to go to a church or what religion to belong to and we beg of you to understand that living the life of the Heavenly Father is not a religion and is not found in the walls of a church building or a congregation of people following unfounded paths in over 4,200 religions on earth today. Your choice is not a religion or a church, but His way of life.

Common sense tells us someone has to be right, and just as the Jews wandered off toward the idolatries of Baal religious worship in the early formation of the nation, Yahweh hated their choice then, and hates idolatrous worship today. He gave them His instructions and they ignored Him. They were far from right in their choice.

Know this as well, the relationship you have with the Creator of all matter and your salvation is a one on one relationship between you and He and no one else. No priest, no pope, no rabbi, no pastor, no elder, or no woman or man can stand up for you in that relationship. Only your choices. *They would save only themselves by their righteousness - (Ezekiel 14:19)*

Please think it through and realize, Adam and Eve did not have a Bible, did not have a church, and did not have a mediator between themselves and our Heavenly Father. Their choice, and their relationship was loving the one who created them because He did. Honor Him and credit Him for doing it by obeying His directives for life. It's that simple, and we do want to warn you, Yahweh is jealous of that relationship and does not want to share you with anyone else *(read newsletter #285)*.

Please be warned that most will come against these truths and will use all sorts of mythical and theological reasonings to attempt to sway you away from His word and the word of His prophets. And, you yourselves may question His word as you compare your life to the lives of those around you.

But as first stated, as individuals you are as different as night and day, and choices are your own individual desires. So beware of the falsehoods that try and keep you from the truth, the path to Him and His glory. Listen to Him, listen to His prophets (read newsletter #57).

The Roman Empire, in man's forced system of calendar dating, found itself in the same position in its 1st Century as the world around us is today. They had their own "way", their own "religion", their own "governance" and the Jews, selected by Yahweh to be the way, and the writings and instructions of their prophetic ancestors, conflicted and in most cases came against the Roman mythical religious system made up of mystical thought and words of impossible understandings. Thus, attempted writings to meld the old and the new produced a "new" testament of a Heavenly Father far different than the Heavenly Father of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and His rescued nation, the Israelis.

We find, however, Yahweh has never changed nor will He ever change. He was the same yesterday, is today and will be tomorrow. His words of truth, and His commandments of life are the same today as they were at the time the first listening ears of adult human beings could listen. And His instructions are based on the foundation of His Kingdom, righteousness, and not the world's rendition of a life of ease, self-centered pleasures and a substitute for sin. (I Yahweh do not change - Malachi 3:6). (Heavenly Father, who is enthroned from of old, who does not change - Psalm 55:19).

While we identify ourselves as a **scattered community**, we do so in full knowledge that each of us has an individual relationship with our Creator, and it is that relationship we fully acknowledge and concentrate on as a community of people who

believe just that. We encourage and aid the personal one-on-one relationship that will be so important when the "scrolls are opened" and are happy that we can help others to know we'll be found in them at judgement.

The Jews gathered together socially to hear Yahweh Himself orally distribute the words of life, and later at, but not in, His Temple to listen to the chosen Priests of Yahweh relay the words of the entire covenant that they might hear and apply the instructions to their lives. The Israeli people were never in a building, nor were they ever a part of any ritualistic system to receive the Word of Yahweh. The word was orally given to them, they heard the truth and it was up to them to apply the truth individually to their lives.

That system of mass gathering ended when the Temple in which they gathered around ended, but the written word was instructed by Yahweh to be taught by the parents to their children with or without the Temple. Unlike religious churches, synagogues, mosques and other such buildings today, Yahweh's Temple was not a house of worship for the masses, but for the select and His Priests to care for and carry out the sacrifices for the nation's sins.

That system of sacrifice and worship ended when the Temple ended and won't begin again until He sets foot in His new Temple in Jerusalem atop Mt. Zion where He will reside and be worshipped forever.

As then, the teachings of His Word and the application of His Word is at an individual level because the relationship He seeks with His human creation is as one-on-one as it was at the garden.

Choosing to believe Him began at Eden. Choosing to love Him began at Eden. Choosing to obey Him began at Eden. Choosing to worship He and He only began at Eden. Choosing death began at Eden and we inherited it. Choosing righteousness as a way of life began at Eden and was tested at the flood.

Just because we are a **scattered community** of individuals, choice is still in our grasp and it is choice that makes the difference between an eternal existence with the One who created us or an existence apart from Him in shame and disgrace. Worse are those who will never see Him or the light of day as they remain in the pit of the earth individually chosen as their eternal destiny.

We so encourage you that as you feel you believe Him, choose Him, thus life and in your patience, know that because of your choice, when the books are opened by His angels for His judgement, you will be found there as a part of His treasure, rescued, and receive your eternal inheritance. (At that time every one of your people whose name is written in the book will be rescued - **Daniel 7:10**).

4. Heaven Is Our Father's Domain

O one goes to heaven! Contrary to religious belief and to the teachings of mystic religions, we are on or in this planet forever. We were created to live on this planet or beneath it depending on the judgment of our Heavenly Father and it is the only planet in all of the universe that He created for us to reside.

Our heaven, or simply the sky as we view it, is a realm He created at the outset as a result of His desires, not ours, and there were not multiple planets created for us to live on. This one was formed out of all of our universe just for us and no one else nor anywhere else.

The reason that is obvious is that He wouldn't have created something He would have been a part of or He would have created Himself, and He didn't. Some may even through mass hypnosis, actually cause you to faint and fall where you stand as they lay their hands on you in an attempt to make you think it is their way to "god".

A huge percentage of the population of earth believe in a mythical "son-god", a savior sent from Heaven and that you must submit to him in order to be saved from sure death without resurrection, and these same institutions use as their basis, words from a new testament of their scriptures created and penned by Romans at a time when the Jews and Romans were at total odds with each other, and a good 360 years or so after their so-called savior died.
