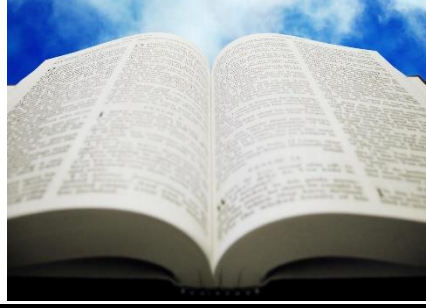


The Bible 101
