Fundraiser – What We Learned



What went well:

- Teacher engagement - tug o war and pie toss, generated from
- Fun Services for Carnival Games - increased fun/decreased mental load and set up labor. No storage of games!
- Sponsorship campaign - significant income
- Increased middle school engagement - 21 kids fundraised for a total \$4,218
- The Inflatable Race was an instant hit - teachers requested it as a yearly event.

Challenges:

- Not enough event volunteers - parent sign up was slow and high school volunteers were scarce
- Sponsorship campaign execution - labor intensive with follow up, materials development, etc.
