2026 Kinderwolf Welcome Coordinator	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Coordinate 2026 Kindergarten welcome event- Engage Incoming 1st grade families- Execute from existing project plan, support from PIE leadership team, plan theme, place orders, set up, etc.- Time Commitment: 4-6 hours in August

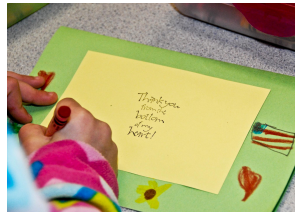
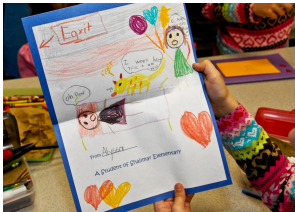

2023-2024 Profits and Rewards: **\$4,249.31** (1 book fair)

2024-2025 Profits and Rewards: **\$3,943.76** (1 book fair and pop-up sale)

2025-2026 P&R : **\$7,617.73** (**93% increase**, Nov. AND Feb. book fairs)

\$3,673 increase in P&R translates to 337 new books for the library
