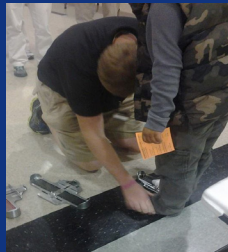

Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet , Inc. is a 501©(3) non-profit organization dedicated to providing children in need with new, high quality footwear. The program was founded in 2009 by Jerry Baird, a retired coal miner from Union County, Kentucky. He has partnered with Shoe Carnival and utilizes local school's family resource youth service centers and others who work with children in the community to help provide students with

quality shoes.

“A child’s physical and mental health is a priority of the program,” said Baird. “Not having basic personal items can distract a child from performing well in school. A new pair of shoes can help build self-esteem and can also stop children from being made fun of or being bullied.”

The Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet project is announcing its addition of Lincoln County to its program. Eligible students will be identified with the help of the Family Resource Youth Service Center directors at each school. Each school year, the selected students will be fitted by Shoe Carnival employees and trained local volunteers to ensure that each child receives shoes that have been properly sized. Each eligible student will choose a pair of shoes from a predetermined selection based on the individual’s age. Shoe Carnival will place the order and the shoes will be delivered to the students at their respective schools.
