Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet

Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet is a successful Non-Profit Organization designed to provide school children with high quality footwear. In 2021, new shoes were provided to 4,731 students within 20 counties across Kentucky and Southern Illinois. Happy Feet works closely with school resource workers, as well as other community members to identify families who could benefit from this program. Shoes are purchased locally and distributed throughout the school year on an as needed basis.

Happy Feet was started in 2009 by Jerry Baird, a retired coal miner from Union County. "A child's physical and mental health is a priority of the program," said Baird. "Not having basic personal items can distract a child from performing well in school. A new pair of shoes can help build self-esteem and a new pair of shoes can also stop children from being made fun of or bullied." Over the last 12 years, there have been 38,997 pairs of shoes distributed to happy and deserving children.

The Caldwell County Chapter of Happy Feet was launched in 2013 and has been very successful. In 2021, Happy Feet was blessed to distribute 467 pairs of shoes to our children. This year we were also extremely lucky to have the funds available to distribute 100 pairs of shoes to help families in our area who lost their homes during the December 10th tornadoes, as well as purchasing for the Special Olympic Basketball team and cheerleaders.

Our goal for the 2022 year is to raise \$7,500 for the 2022-2023 school year. We have begun to see a greater need than ever for shoes for our kids, and with your help, we can make that happen!
