2. PROGRAMED ACTIVITIES

With the noted exceptions below, all activities take place at Vientos Bajos, El Empalme.

a. Music Groups

Our music groups are now forming for 2022. We will begin rehearsals Wednesday, January 12. All groups have open enrollment. We provide sheet music for all groups, and instruments for many. If you're interested in any of our groups, please contact us so we can put you on the special contact list. We begin our music groups. In order to give us lots of practice time, we're focusing on our first presentation to be for Earth Day, Friday, April 22, which we will celebrate Sunday, April 24. There is no charge to participate in any of the instrumental groups. Chorus requires a fee of 1k CRC per session.

- ◆ Ukulele Band, 10:00 AM, WED. (No experience required.) This is a fun, beginning music group. You do not need a music background to participate. A basic knowledge of ukulele or guitar chords is helpful, but not required. This is a back-up sing-along group—we chord while our audience joins us for sing-along songs. If you want to learn a musical instrument and spend some time socializing, this is your opportunity.
- ◆ Recorder Ensemble, 1 PM, WED. (Must read music) This group is for those who read music. Most of were exposed to the recorder in the fourth grade. Even if you have never played the recorder, it's a fairly easy instrument to learn—if you read music. We currently have openings for all four parts—soprano, alto, tenor, and bass. We can provide a soprano or alto recorder, but if you want to play a, tenor or bass, you'll need to provide your own instrument. The music we choose is probably 1.5 to 2.0 level.
- → Bluegrass Band (NEW), 2 PM WED. (Experience required.) Our bluegrass band began playing in 2021. We are a jam session, but provide music. We will provide music and develop sets to play for various events. If you play any bluegrass instrument and can read chord charts, you're invited to join us. Please contact us if you're interested and let us know what instrument you'll be playing.
- ◆ B-flat instruments, 3:00 PM, WED. (Must read music and have experience with a b flat instrument) Trumpets, clarinets, oboes, trombones, bassoons, baritones/ euphoniums, and tubas. All musicians in the group should be able to read music and have experience with their instrument. Our sheet music is generally level 1.5 to 3.0 and we have sheet music for both bass and treble clef. We have an extra trumpet and baritone for your use. If you need a different instrument, please let us know and we'll see what we can do.
- ★ Mixed Chorus (NEW!) We are beginning mixed chorus on 10 AM, TUE off-campus at the Jose Figueres Cultural Center in downtown San Ramon. No formal musical training is required. Just bring your voice and we'll go from there. The numbers we will be singing will be unison or two-part, and all will be beginning-easy level. Because these numbers are easy, rehearsals will begin in early January. There is a 1k CRC charge per person per rehearsal for the use of the hall and the cost of the music. If you're interested, PLEASE contact us so we can start a roster. Please note: The Figueres Center requires any participant to be fully vaccinated. Masks are also required.


