

MUSIC GROUPS

All activities take place at Vientos Bajos. With all groups having done an exceptional job of presentation at the Earth Day Celebration, all groups are again open as we begin work and new music for Oktoberfest, planned for Sunday, September 4.

General information: We provide sheet music for all groups, and instruments for many. If you're interested in any of our groups, please contact us so we can put you on the special contact list. There is no charge to participate in any of the instrumental groups. See the individual write-ups for the various groups below to see if you'd like to join us. All groups meet on Wednesdays, but there is a possibility of some Thursday groups. See note in the Weekly Activities section.

Ukulele Band, 10:00AM, WED

No experience required. This is a fun, beginning music group. You do not need a music background to participate. A basic knowledge of ukulele or guitar chords is helpful, but not required. This is a backup singalong group—we chord while our audience joins us for singalong songs. If you want to learn a musical instrument and spend some time socializing, this is your opportunity. We have an extra ukulele or two available if you don't have your own instrument.





Bluegrass Band, 1:30PM WED

Experience required. Our bluegrass band began playing together in 2021. We are a jam session but provide chord charts. We develop sets to play for various events. If you play any bluegrass instrument and can read chord charts, you're invited to join us. Please contact us if you're interested and let us know what instrument you'll be playing.

Recorder Ensemble, 2:30PM WED

Must read music. This group is for those who read music. Most of us were exposed to the recorder in the third or fourth grade. Even if you have never played the recorder, it's a fairly easy instrument to learn—if you read music. We currently have openings for all four parts—soprano, alto, tenor, and bass. We can provide a soprano or alto recorder, but if you want to play a tenor or bass, you'll need to provide your own instrument—or notify us so we can find one for you. On a scale of zero to 5, the music we choose is probably 1.5 to 2.0 level.





B-flat instruments, 3:30PM WED

Must read music and have experience with a B-flat instrument. Trumpets, clarinets, oboes, trombones, bassoons, baritones/euphoniums, and tubas. All musicians in the group should be able to read music and have experience with their instrument. Our sheet music is generally level 1.5 to 3.0 (on a 0–5 scale) and we have sheet music for both bass and treble clef. We have an extra trumpet, trombone, and

baritone for your use. (See photo.) If you need a different instrument, please let us know and we'll see what we can do.


Mixed Chorus

If you feel you can carry a tune, we'd love to have you join us. Reading music is not required, but extremely helpful. No formal musical training is required—just bring your voice and we'll go from there. We'll be singing unison or two-part numbers, and to start, all



music will be beginning-easy level. We're looking for all ranges—sopranos, altos, tenors, and basses. If you don't know which you are, we'll figure it out for you. Due to the coronavirus, mixed chorus was suspended in 2020. With most people now having their vaccinations, we are planning to restart mixed chorus in July. We will continue to test the waters concerning the virus status, so the start date is tentative. If you're interested, please let us know. We'll put you on the list and notify you when we start up.






Buganvilla Apartment (Vientos Bajos)
