Pickleball Classes, Beginning NOV 4, 2019.

Beginning Pickleball. We know you've heard about the game. Interesting in seeing what it's like? Vientos Bajos is offering a one-month beginner's class. Join our instructors, Rick Reimer and Kyle Baker to learn the basics of the game. Classes will be offered Mondays and Wednesdays, beginning 4 NOV on the VB courts. Previous sign-up is necessary to coordinate number of students and schedule the hour of the day. Be sure to wear appropriate shoes and shorts. (It can be a warm game.) Paddles and other pickleball equipment will be provided.

Details: The beginning class will last four weeks, teach the basics. You will be playing pickleball from the first day. Classes last 90 minutes. Attend your first two classes for free. If you decide to stick with it, you will be asked to join Vientos Bajos—membership is 10k colones per month or 2k colones per use of the court. There will be no extra charge for the remaining classes. If you can't make the first or second class, no problem. Contact us to see what you can schedule. If you can't make MON or WED, we also may be available to schedule an alternate time if there are other students available.

Proviso: Not an athlete? Not to worry. Although basic athletic skills are an advantage, these skills aren't necessary to have fun, learn, and play the game. If you've been wanting to start or gently increase your exercise regimen, this may be what you've been looking for—an opportunity to learn a new game, increase your



exercise, meet new people, and most importantly, have FUN. Don't let any perceptions like "I'm not an athlete" hold you back. Pickleball is the fastest growing 55+ recreational activity in the world. Join us to find out the reason.

Beginning-Intermediate Pickleball Clinic. While John Buford was in the States, in SEP, he made a pointed effort to become certified as a pickleball instructor/coach by the major pickleball organization in the world, the USA Pickleball Association (USAPA) as well as the Professional Pickleball Registry (PPR). He is offering to share the skills and techniques he learned in his certification in a series of pickleball clinics for beginner-intermediates. Again, there will be no cost for these clinics, but everyone will be required to be a member of Vientos Bajos (10k/month).

For the past eight years, walkers have met regularly to experience different parts of the San Ramon area. Some bring dogs. This is a "join us if you want, or don't" activity. We generally meet at the chosen place to begin the walk at 7 AM and finish the walk within an hour.



On a scale of 1-5, 5 being high, the walks generally are between 2.5 and 3.5. We walk seven days a week. Walk at your own pace. Some of the walks are loops, many are 25 to 30-minute walks with a turn-around. We currently have about 25 people on the Walking Club email list.
