# **EQUITY EMPOWERMENT CONTINUUM**

The Equity Empowerment Continuum (EEC) (Reed, 2025) provides a framework to navigate and assess progress toward fairness and justice.





#### WHITE PHASE

The white phase reflects deliberate resistance to change, with actions that "dial back progress" or ignore disparities, often dismantling gains toward inclusion and fairness.




### **LIGHT GRAY PHASE**

The light gray phase shows surface-level engagement, marked by performative allyship and symbolic gestures that fail to address systemic barriers or create lasting change.



## **DARK GRAY PHASE**

The dark gray phase marks intentional action, where leaders use ICE-T—identity, context, experiences, and timing—and their spheres of influence to build accountability and foster collaboration, aligning actions with values to dismantle barriers.



### **BLACK PHASE**

The black phase embodies systemic justice, where progress is embedded and endures beyond leadership. Rare but aspirational, it guides ongoing efforts toward justice.
