2025 Rim Country Roundup Quilt Show

Categories & Definitions

- **1.** <u>Artistic</u> Art, Modern, Pictorial. An original form and composition created by the entrant is encouraged. Original design will likely place with a higher award than an entry made using a commercial/published pattern.
- 2. Group When 3 or more persons have created the quilt.
- **3.** <u>Kit</u> Quilts where the quilt top fabric is not selected by the entrant. This includes patterns, fabrics, threads, and/or quilting designs that are packaged as a unit for sale as well as Block of the Month programs where the block fabric is supplied by a vendor, pattern designer, quilt shops, or quilts made from class kits.
- **4.** <u>Machine Embroidery</u> Machine Embroidery must predominate over all other techniques. This includes "computer programmed" Embroidery.
- **5.** <u>Masters</u> This category is for those elite quilters/individuals who have received a 1st place or Best of Show award in a national or international quilt show, this also includes certified judges, and those that teach quilting related classes nationally or internationally for hire.
- **6.** <u>Traditional Pieced Quilt predominately pieced using traditional methods.</u>
- 7. <u>Traditional Other Techniques A quilt that does not fit into any other category</u>. Hand Applique designs, Crazy Quilt, Cathedral Window, Whole Cloth, Yo-Yo, Panels, Paper-Pieced, Photo Transfer, etc..
- **8.** <u>Youth Non-Judged</u> Exhibitor age must be 18 or younger as of November 3, 2025.

- **9.** <u>Display Non-Judged entry to be displayed as space allows.</u> Entrants are allowed to enter up to 2 items.
- **10.** <u>Special Exhibit –</u> A quilt entered in this category must depict the Challenge "An Adventure in Rim Country". Must meet all the Challenge guidelines set forth in the Rules and Regulations.
