Entry Application Requirements

Entry Deadline Saturday, October 16, 2021

Entry Fee: Fee Waived

Entry Packet:

→ A separate entry form must be provided for each item.

- → A non-returnable, color photograph (no slides) or JPEG of each entry item must be submitted with the application. A photo of an unfinished item may be submitted, however, it must show a recognizable pattern and color.
- → Provide <u>an email address OR enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope</u> in order to receive entry confirmation.
- → Only 3 judged and 1 display entry per entrant is allowed

To be eligible for participation, entry forms must be received no later than the entry deadline of Saturday, October 16, 2021. Entry confirmations will be sent out after September 24. If you do not receive a confirmation by October 31, 2021, please contact Elaine Putnam at 928-978-3464.

Entry Rules

To qualify for entry, the quilt must consist of three (3) layers: Top, Batting, Backing. No false backs will be allowed. The ONLY exception is the Potpourri category.

Quilts previously exhibited in any previous Rim Country Quilt Roundup shows are ineligible for entry.

Kit Quilts, Blocks of the Month and pre-printed panels must be entered in the "KIT QUILT" category. They will not be accepted in any other category. They will not be eligible for "Best Use of Color" award.

All entries must be completed within the last three (3) years.

Entries that have previously won an award at the National Quilt Show competition level must be entered as "Display".

Novice entries must have less than two years of experience and have not previously won the "Novice" award.

All quilts accepted for the show must be finished, clean, and undamaged. Prospective submittals deemed to be incomplete, torn, damaged, soiled, or odorous will not be accepted.

Only ONE item per category will be accepted from an entrant. Only three judged entries and 1 display entry per entrant.

An entry confirmation notice and drop off location will be sent by e-mail or US Mail upon completion of entry form processing. **Please follow all instructions.**

Computer aided machine applique will be judged as embroidery.

To ensure compliance with Copyright Laws, always provide attribution information (name) about the quilter, and/or pattern designer. If not an original design, design credit MUST be given to the source.

Display Requirements

Quilts accepted for display must have an open-ended, 4" quilt hanging sleeve securely stitched to the top back of the quilt. Quilts without a quilt hanging sleeve will not be displayed in the show.

Quilt hanging sleeves must be placed on the **WIDTH** or **SMALLER** side of the quilt. The sleeve for a bed runner must be across the **NARROW** side.

Quilts over 90" long must have the top of the quilt sleeve at 90" to prevent the quilt from dragging on the floor. Quilts that do not meet this requirement will be displayed at the discretion of the Quilt Intake Committee.

Miniature quilts may have sleeves of only 2" in diameter or loops appropriate for their size.

Wearables are exempt from sleeve requirement.

For the exhibitor's protection, all entry items **must be labeled** with the maker's name and title of the quilt sewn on the back. Clearly visible embroidery is also acceptable.

While on display, no quilt or wearable will be removed or released before the end of the show.

Definitions

Categories:

Applique Category 1100

Appliqué predominates over piecing or other.

Art Category 1200

An original composition with emphasis on color, line, and design. This category features abstract

Group Category 1300

A quilt made by 3 or more individuals who actively shared in its creation. It must not be the product of a business arrangement or the result of a work-for-hire agreement.

Machine Embroidery Category 1400

Machine embroidery predominates over any other technique. This includes any "computer programmed" embroidery or applique design.

Mixed Technique Category 1500

Quilt displays multiple techniques in the design.

Modern Category 1600

Quilts may include the use of improvisational piecing, substantial negative space, bold colors, high contrast and graphic areas of solid colors or bold graphic prints.

Paper Pieced – Small/Medium Category 1700

Piecing using foundation piecing methods predominate over any other technique either in amount or effect. This does not include English paper piecing. Width is less than 75 inches. Perimeter is less than 301 inches.

Paper Pieced – Large Category 1800

Piecing using foundation piecing methods predominate over any other technique either in amount or effect. This does not include English paper piecing.

Pictorial Category 1900

A quilt that uses a variety of fabrics to illustrate a recognizable pictorial image: nature, cityscape, wildlife, people, pets, etc. It may be any size.

Pieced – Small Category 2000

Piecing predominates over any other technique. Width is 50 inches or less. Perimeter is 200 inches or less.

Pieced – Medium Category 2100

Piecing predominates over any other technique. Width is greater than 50 inches and less than 75 inches. Perimeter is between 201 inches and 300 inches.

Pieced – Large Category 2200

Piecing predominates over any other technique. Width is 75 inches or greater. Perimeter is greater than 300 inches.

Junior Quilt Category 2300

Exhibitor must be age 18 or younger as of November 12, 2021.

Potpourri Category 2400

Quilts may include the use of any of the following techniques: Cathedral Window, Crazy Quilt, Miniatures, hand embroidery, whole cloth, yo-yos, etc.)

Display Category 2500

Non-judged entry to be displayed as space allows. Entrants are allowed to enter up to two quilts or wearables in this category. Kit quilts, panels and pre-printed whole cloths must be entered as "KIT QUILTS".

Kit Quilt Category 2600

This category has been established to allow quilters the opportunity to enter Block of the Month, quilt kits and panels. Quilts that were created **with all or any part of a quilt kit** must be entered in this category. BOM and Kit Quilts will not be accepted in any other category. Quilts in this category are not eligible for the "Best Use Of Color" award.

Special Exhibit Category 2700

A quilt entered in this category will be part of an exhibit with a "like" theme.

Special Award Categories

Hand Appliqué - Quilt is 50% or more appliquéd by hand.

Hand Embroidery - All embroidery is 100% hand embroidered.

Hand Quilting - Quilt is entirely quilted by hand.

Machine Appliqué - Quilt is 50% or more appliquéd by non-computer aided machine.

Non-Professional Machine Quilting - Quilt has been machine quilted by a non-professional quilter.

Professional Machine Quilting - Quilt has been machine quilted by one who quilts for monetary gain.

The Intake Committee and/or Judges reserve the right to make all final adjustments regarding the placement of quilts into a category. At its discretion and to facilitate the judging process, the Intake Committee may combine or divide the categories.
