2023 Rim Country Quilt Roundup Rules & Regulations

- 1. Entry forms must be received no later than midnight, October 15, 2023. Entries received after this date will be returned.
- 2. Submit ONE (1) entry form per entry. Exhibitors are limited to a total of four (4) entries, only three (3) of which may be judged. Up to 2 entries (2) per category is permitted. Display Only quilts will be hung based on space availability. Entries must have been completed after October of 2019 and cannot have been exhibited at a previous Quilt Roundup quilt show.
- 3. Only 130 quilt entries will be judged. Quilts will be accepted for judging based on the order the entry forms are received. Entries submitted into judged categories after the limit is reached will be given the opportunity to change to a Display Only category or to withdraw the entry. A quilt shown in Display Only will not be eligible to be entered in future years.
- 4. All entries must be, clean, free of pet-hair, and odor. Any entry which reflects any of these conditions will not be accepted by the Judging/Intake Committee. All entries must have a hanging sleeve, consist of three layers (top, batting and backing) and contain quilting, unless entered in "Potpourri" Category. Tied quilts will not be accepted (excluding crazy quilts or youth quilts). Quilts with a false back will not be eligible for judging. The hanging sleeve should be 4" wide (or appropriate for the size of the quilt) and sewn to the quilt; quilts with pinned sleeves will not be accepted.
- 5. A 2023 Entry Label is to be pinned on the lower left-hand corner when looking at the back of the quilt. This required label will be included in the entrant's confirmation packet. Labels or other information (on the front or back of the entry) identifying the quiltmaker/quilter on items to be judged must be covered with fabric or paper and secured with basting stitches or safety pins. Please do not use straight pins.
- 6. Quilts made from kits (including blocks of the month with fabric packets), pre-printed whole cloths, pre-printed panels or "cheater cloth" must be placed in the judged "KIT QUILT" category but will not be eligible for Best of Show or Best Use Of Color.
- 7. Quilts mounted on wood stretcher bars or framed (wood or metal), with or without glass, will not be accepted. No accompanying items will be hung with the quilt, i.e., glass or ceramic, storyboards, photographs, etc. No profanity or suggestive language in the quilt description or on the quilt will be accepted. No distasteful images may appear on a quilt for judging or display.

- 8. Quilt WIDTH may not exceed 108". All quilts longer than 90" must have a sleeve placed 90" from the quilt bottom. The quilt top will then be draped over the hanging pole. The sleeve placement will prevent the quilt from touching the floor.
- 9. The Judging Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, re-categorize any item or disqualify any item from the judging portion of the quilt show. Entrants shall be notified of such decision as soon as possible.
- 10. The cost of shipping quilt entries to and from the show is the entrant's responsibility. All mailed quilt entries must include a prepaid return shipping label, unless such entry is to be picked up at the quilt show.
- 11. All entries are subject to copyright laws. All entrants are required to give credit for all inspiration derived from other quilts, books, quilt makers, patterns, etc.
- 12. Judging will be done by the elimination method. First Place, Second Place, and Third Place Awards MAY be awarded in each category at the sole discretion of the judges. All ribbons are awarded to the quilt entrant, except for the Exemplary Quilting ribbons, which are awarded to the named Quilter.
