Step 1: Determine if you are eligible

Eligible applicants are young adults who:

- are graduating seniors between the ages of 16 and 19
- have a grade point average of 3.0 or greater

Step 2: Complete the application (available online at quiltroundup.org/Scholarships)

To fill out the application using the PDF online form:

- Select the "Sign" tool.
- Select "Fill and "Sign".
- Click on "Add Text". Place your cursor on each line that requires information. Begin entering your personal information. (Note: You will not be able to change the type size. Please limit your answers to the space allotted.)
- To fill out the "Essay" portion of the form, place your cursor on the first blank line. The text will wrap as you reach the end of each line. Continue typing your entire essay (not to exceed 750 words).
- Once all parts of the form are personalized, select "Save As" from the "File" menu and change the file name (for example, "RCQRemailappEX.pdf," where "EX" is replaced with your initials). Click "Save."
