COURSE OVERVIEW

This Basic SWAT course is designed to provide students with an understanding and application of Basic SWAT tactics and fundamentals. Each student will be asked to perform these tactics and demonstrate an understanding on how each is used, and when to apply each of these tactics or tools during critical incidents they may face.

Simunitions and live fire will be integrated into the SWAT training curriculum throughout the week. Each topic covered below will be performed using role players or shoot no-shoot targets.

There will be no hypothetical instruction. Everything instructed is coming from our firsthand experiences gained through live missions and thousands of hours of training.

- 9. Proper deployment of window teams on HRT's and Search Warrants
- 10. Down Officer/Citizen rescue
- 11. The use and proper deployment of a ram
- 12. NFDD flash bang
- 13. NFDD flash bang pole
- 14. Break and Rake
- 15. 40MM less lethal
