Course Description:

This Basic SWAT course is designed to provide students with an understanding and application of Basic SWAT tactics and fundamentals. Each student will be asked to perform these tactics, gaining the understanding on how each is used, and when to apply these tactics or tools during critical incidents they may face.

Simunitions and live fire will be integrated into the SWAT training curriculum throughout the week. Each topic covered below will be performed using role players or shoot no-shoot targets.

The following topics will be covered and integrated within each discipline:

- Deliberate clears with/without the use of a shield
- Basic Room Entries
- Controlled Entry Tactic/High Risk entries
- Stacks on approach and breach
- Hostage Rescue Techniques/ Using primary and secondary entry points
- Vehicle Assaults
- Surround and callout/ Taking custodies
- Safe and proper weapon handling and manipulation
- Taking subject into custody within a structure as well as open air
- Proper deployment of window teams on HRT's and Search Warrants
- Down Officer/Citizen rescue

The use of the following tools will be covered and introduced while conducting the above disciplines:

- Proper use of a ram
- NFDD flash bang
- NFDD flash bang pole
- Break and Rake
- 40MM less lethal
- Introducing how to deploy and importance of a Ballistic Shotgun during critical incidents (Demo only)

There will be no hypothetical instruction. Everything instructed is coming from firsthand experiences as current team leaders and current explosive breachers. We gained our experience through running Hostage Rescues, Armed Barricades, Vehicle Barricades and High Risk Search Warrants: In addition to thousand of hours of training these tactics.
