

Middletown Bocce Ball League
Fund Raising Games
July 18, 2026 6:00 P.M.

These games are for individual players, including non- members, not teams.
Time permitting, some games might be played multiple times. Players may buy into additional games.

Closest to Backboard

- ▶ \$10.00 buy-in per player.
- ▶ 5 players per game.
- ▶ Each player throws 4 balls to see how close to the backboard. A ball that hits the backboard is out of play.
- ▶ After throwing, the closest throw by that player is recorded and the balls are picked up.
- ▶ At the end of competition the closest to the backboard wins \$20.00. In case of a tie, the tied players will each throw another ball to determine the winner.

Closest to Pallino

- ▶ \$10.00 buy-in per player.
- ▶ 5 players per game.
- ▶ Each player throws 4 balls at the pallino, which will be positioned in the middle of the hitting line. The closest throw is recorded and the balls are picked up. A ball that hits the backboard without hitting another ball is out of play.
- ▶ The the closest to the pallino wins \$20.00. In case of a tie, the tied players will each roll another ball to determine the winner.

Pinball

- ▶ \$10.00 buy-in per player.
- ▶ 5 players per game.
- ▶ 5 bocce balls are positioned across the court at the hitting line. The middle ball is worth 5 points. The next 2 balls, each three feet from the side board, are worth 3 points each. The last 2 balls are each positioned 6 inches from the side board and are worth 1 point each. A player can score only once on each positioned ball – after it is hit it is no longer in play.
- ▶ The player rolls 4 balls in an attempt to score points by hitting the balls, and his score is tallied. The balls are re-positioned for the next player. The highest score wins \$20.00. In case two players are tied after the first set of throws, another set of 4 balls will be thrown by the tied players to determine the winner.

1 on 1 Matches

- ▶ \$10.00 buy-in per player.
- ▶ In each match 2 players are paired based on their sign-up order. The two players compete in 2 traditional bocce frames.
- ▶ Flip a coin and play by normal rules down and back (2 frames). Each player has 4 balls to throw in each frame.
- ▶ The highest score from the 2 frames wins \$10.00. Ties are broken by an additional frame.
