LOGOS CLASSICAL ACADEMY MUSIC CONSERVATORY POLICY

Enrollment in the Conservatory constitutes a commitment to the entire academic year. Exceptions to this policy are rare and must be reviewed and approved by the Dean of Fine Arts. Students who withdraw early without prior approval may not be eligible to re-enroll in the program.

Student Commitment

- Attend all scheduled lessons on time and arrive prepared with necessary materials (instrument, sheet music, etc.).
- Practice regularly as assigned by the instructor to ensure steady progress.
- Engage fully during lessons with attentiveness, respect, and a willingness to learn.

Parent Commitment

- Ensure consistent and punctual attendance at all lessons.
- Support their child in maintaining a regular and focused practice schedule at home.
- Communicate promptly with instructors regarding any absences, conflicts, or concerns.
- Encourage a positive attitude toward music study and provide a supportive home environment.

Tuition and Attendance Policy

- Tuition is required for participation in the Conservatory Program and is billed monthly.
- The full invoiced amount is due regardless of student attendance, except in cases of long-term illness or other exceptional circumstances approved by the Dean.
- A late fee of \$15 will be applied to any payments received after the due date.
- If your child must miss a lesson due to an excused absence, we will make every effort to reschedule; however, make-up lessons are not guaranteed.
