City Working on 150 Yard Range

- The city of TorC has been working with Jim Paxon and Charlie Bonner to scope out improvements to the 150 yard rifle range which is just east of the main rifle range.
- A Memorandum of Understanding between the City of TorC and Sierra County should be forthcoming within a month. This would allow county resources, mainly heavy equipment, to assist with work on the range.
- Sierra County has indicated that they would appreciate any help the club could provide with respect to fuel costs. An amount of \$1000 was suggested. After some discussion it was agreed that the club would like to help as much as we could but some fundraising efforts and donations would be required.
- Mike Boyd made a motion to allocate up to \$1000 as funds become available to Sierra County for fuel costs associated with the 150 yard range improvements. Seconded by George Tobin. Motion carried.
- It was also noted that we would need to locate or build new forms for bench tops. We will eventually need to add couple of shooting benches at this range.
