### **Match Start Times**

- We will be changing match times to start earlier now that it is getting hot.
- **Pistol Match (Fun Shoot):** Setup at 7:30AM, Shoot at 8:00. Starting immediately.
- **Long Range and .22 Rifle Matches:** Will move to setup at 8:00, shoot at 8:30 starting April 25 for .22, and May 2 for long range.
- There will be **no long range matches** in June, July, or August.
- There will be **no .22 matches in July, August.** June is yet to be determined.
